

Ship Rosalie off Warren 1840

Wicks Employed on Ship's Duty. Ship heading W by N at 10 PM wind blew to the ENE and S W latter part light breeze and calm to ender. Lat by obs 42° 20' long 168° 40'

Wednesday August the 12

These 24 hours came with light breeze and calm ship under all sail. Steaming NW in company with the ship Caladonia of Steaming Borne. Middle part light breeze latter part fine breeze from the W by N and Pleasant to ender. Lat by obs 42° 20' long 168° 40'

Thursday August the 13

These 24 hours came with a fine breeze from the W by N and pleasant ship under all sail. By the wind to the S W work employed on Ship's Duty. Middle part light breeze and breeze at 4 PM wind blowing to the NNE latter part light breeze and strong to ender. So obs this day.

Friday August the 14

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the S E and strong ship under all sail. By the wind N by E. At 1 PM we saw ship to the South. Middle part light breeze and Pleasant at 9 AM saw sperm whale at 10 AM board the boat and struck and turned up a whale and a few calves. So ends.

Saturday August the 15

These 24 hours came with light breeze all hands employed in taking whale to the ship. Took 4 whale long fins lost one at 6 PM took in whale and set the watch. Middle part fine breeze at 6 PM began cutting in at 10 PM cut in barrels to ender. Lat by obs 42° 40' long 168° 50'

Sunday August the 16

These 24 hours came with strong breeze and ship under all hands employed on

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at one PM finished cutting barrel said we saw ship to the S W all hands employed cutting up quarters. Began at 7 PM set the watch. Middle part thick misty weather latter part much the same to ender. Lat by obs 42° 30' long 168° 20'

Monday August the 17

These 24 hours came with fine gales from the S E and thick foggy weather. Ship under double reef. Sails set. Middle part fine breeze and strong at 10 AM finished cutting latter part more pleasant. Lat by obs 42° 50' long 168° 50'

Tuesday August the 18

These 24 hours came with a fine breeze from the S W ship under double reef. Sails set. Middle part fine breeze at 6 PM began cutting down oil. Latter part fine breeze and pleasant to ender. Lat by obs 42° 10' long 168° 40'

Wednesday August the 19

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the South and pleasant weather. Ship under all sail. By the wind all hands employed on Steaming down oil at 6 PM finished. Middle part light breeze at 8 PM squally. Breeze in the fore part sails. Latter part light breeze and thick weather to ender. So obs this day. Long in 17° 05' west.

Thursday August the 20

These 24 hours came with the light breeze from the S E and haze weather. Ship under all sail. Middle part light breeze and passing clouds. Latter part fine and fine weather to ender. Lat by obs 42° 50' long 170° 20'
