Friday August the 21

There 24 hours calm with slight breeze from the South ship under all sail by the wind reach Compt. Middle part calm latter part strong gales double height the topsails saw three ships S.E. Lat 23° 06' long 173° 31'

Saturday August the 22

There 24 hours calm with strong gale from the South ship under double reef topsails steering to the S.W. at 5 P.M. speak the ship Java of New Bedford at 6 P.M. sails West the main topsails Middle part fresh gale latter part continued the same Lat 23° 23' long 173° 25'

Sunday August the 23

There 24 hours calm with strong gale from the Eastward ship heading on the wind to the Southward three ships in sight heading to the South Middle part fresh breeze at 6 A.M. made all sail latter part light breeze and fair weather three ships in sight Lat 24° 17' long 172° 55'

Monday August the 24

There 24 hours calm with slight breeze from the S.E. ship under all sail by the wind steering to the Southward Middle part light breeze and fresh latter part fine breeze from the East Lat 24° 53' long 173° 32'

Tuesday August the 25

There 24 hours calm with a fine breeze from the Eastward ship under all sail sails employed on ship sails Middle part fresh breeze at 5 A.M. set the main topsails at 9 A.M. wind backing further the topsails sail latter part fresh breeze and fair weather this day Lat 24° 55' long 173° 35'

Wednesday August the 26

There 24 hours calm with slight breeze from the South ship under her topsails at 4 P.M. Jacket ship to the W. & W. Middle part light breeze and variable at 2 A.M. more ship to the S.W. & W. latter part light breeze and fair weather Lat 25° 16' long 173° 57'

Thursday August the 27

There 24 hours calm with a light breeze from the S.W. and pleasant ship under all sail sails employed on ship sails Middle part fresh breeze at 5 A.M. fresh breeze from the Westward Sea line got and main sails double height the topsails at 6 A.M. made all sail latter part fresh gale saw numerous of galleons Lat 25° 23' long 173° 19'

Friday August the 28

There 24 hours calm with a fresh gale and passing clouds ship under double reef topsails steering on the wind to the S.E. Middle part strong gale at one A.M. fresh breeze in the main sail latter part with gale and passing clouds Lat 25° 25' long 173° 38'

Saturday August the 29

There 24 hours begins with fresh gale from the S.W. ship under single reef topsails steering on the wind to the S.E. Middle part light breeze at 11 A.M. wind backing to the Westward at 8 A.M. wind backing double height the topsails at 10 A.M. about West the main topsails in line the fore and main topsails latter part heavy gale Lat 25° 31' long 173° 40'

Sunday August the 30

There 24 hours calm with a heavy gale from the Eastward ship under all sail sails employed on ship sails Middle part fresh breeze at 5 A.M. set the main topsails at 9 A.M. wind backing further the topsails sail latter part fresh breeze and fair weather this day Lat 25° 55' long 173° 55'
