Monday August the 31

These 24 hours commences with heavy gale from the westward ship still lying low under chart Reef main topsails and fore sail Middle part heavy gale at 3 AM wind ship to the North latter part heavy gale and Reef down
Lat By obs 34° 50' S Long in

Tuesday Sept the 1st

These 24 hours commences with heavy gale from the westward ship still lying low under chart Reef main topsails and fore sail Middle part heavy gale at 6 AM set the fore sail and Mizzen at 7 AM set the fore and Mizzen topsails and at 8 AM wind evening fresh in sail and low low latter part heavy gale to E winds all the day

Wednesday Sept the 2nd

These 24 hours commences with heavy gale from the westward ship still lying low under chart Reef main topsails and fore sail Middle part fresh gale at 6 AM set the fore sail at 8 AM set fore and Mizzen topsails latter part more moderate to E winds
Lat By obs 34° 30' S Long in 171° 15' W

Thursday Sept the 3rd

These 24 hours commences with fresh gale and though low ship under chart Reef topsails at one PM set the main sail ship head to the S E Middle part light breeze at 6 AM wind sail ship South latter part fresh breeze
Lat By obs 34° 45' S Long in 171° 21' W

Friday Sept the 4th

These 24 hours commences with fresh breeze from the S W ship under chart Reef topsails at 4 PM spoke the ship Lincoln Breeze
Lat By obs 34° 50' S Long in 171° 30' W

Saturday Sept the 5th

These 24 hours commences with a fresh breeze from the westward ship under chart Reef topsails heading to the S E was 6 AM spoke the ship Duty at 8 AM shorter sail Middle part fresh breeze at 7 PM set the fore topsails at 8 PM wind evening fresh in sail By obs 32° 52' S Long in 172° 41'

Sunday Sept the 6th

These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the S E ship under chart Reef main topsails and fore sail head to the westward Middle part fresh breeze at 6 AM set the fore sail at 7 AM spoke the ship Duty at 9 AM set fore and Mizzen topsails latter part fresh gale to E winds
Lat By obs 32° 39' S Long in 171° 54' W

Monday Sept the 7th

These 24 hours commences with strong gale from the S E ship under chart Reef main topsails at 6 AM shorter sail head to the S E Middle part light breeze and fine weather at 8 AM wind all sail and stood to the S E latter part light breeze to E winds Lat By obs 32° 10' S Long in

Tuesday Sept the 8th

These 24 hours commences with a light breeze from the S E ship under all sail steering on the wind to the Eastward at 6 AM fresh in sail head to the S E Middle part light breeze at 8 AM wind sail and stood S E latter part light breeze and then day long in 173° 10' W

Wednesday Sept the 9th

These 24 hours commences with light breeze from the S W ship under all sail to the Eastward at 6 AM shorter sail and low wind sail latter part fresh breeze Lat By obs 32° 10' S Long in
