

Continued 1840

Sunday Sept the 20

These 24 hours came with fresh gales from the NW and heavy weather. Ship under Single Reef Topsails heading to the SE at 4 PM took in sail. Middle part light breeze at 6 AM main all sail shut & E & E later part light breeze and heavy sea. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Monday Sept the 21

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the SE and heavy sea. Ship under all sail by the wind head to the SE nothing in sight at 6 PM shortened sail. Middle part light breeze at 6 AM main sail shut & E & E later part light breeze and rough sea on SE end. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Tuesday Sept the 22

These 24 hours came with slight breeze from the SE and heavy weather. Ship under all sail at 2 PM saw weight whale board the boat and cast but did not strike at 6 PM shortened sail head to the Eastward. Middle part light breeze at 6 AM main sail shut & E & E later part light breeze and heavy sea. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Wednesday Sept the 23

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the South and heavy weather. Ship under single Reef Topsails heading to the SE at 4 PM saw one weight whale at 6 PM shortened sail. Middle part fresh breeze at 6 AM main sail and shut to the E & E later part squally. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Thursday Sept the 24

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the South attended with light squalls at 6 PM shortened sail and heavy sea to the SE. Middle part

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at 6 PM main sail at 9 AM ordered the main topsails and went away on sail in light later part light breeze. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Friday Sept the 25

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the South at one PM spoke the French ship Jones with two oil at 6 PM shortened sail head to the SE. Middle part calm at 6 AM main sail shut & E & E later part light breeze. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Saturday Sept the 26

These 24 hours came with breeze from the North ship under all sail. String & E & E were employed on ship's duty at 6 PM shortened sail head to the Eastward at 6 PM main sail and shut & E & E one sail in light. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Sunday Sept the 27

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the NW & E ship under all sail at one PM saw one weight whale board the boat did not strike at 6 PM shortened sail. Middle part fresh breeze at 6 AM set single Reef Topsails main sail and gill at 9 AM took in the gill and main sail. Later part fresh gale. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'

Monday Sept the 28

These 24 hours came with fresh gales from the NW & E ship under single Reef Topsails string to the Eastward. Thick & heavy weather at 6 PM shortened sail. Middle part light breeze at 6 AM main sail at 7 AM saw one weight whale board the boat and went about. Later part the lines got cut but whale later part light breeze. Lat 35° 45' S Long 171° 40'
