

New Zealand: 1840

Tuesday Sept the 29

Three 24 hours came with a light breeze from the westward ship under all sail steering on the wind to the Eastward at 8 PM Shorten sail and more ship to the SE at 10 Middle part light breeze at 1 PM made sail and to SE to the part which breeze left by the South Long 18 25 30

Wednesday Sept the 30

Three 24 hours came with a light breeze from the SE ship under all sail at one PM took in the main topgallant and the topgallant the topsails at 6 PM took in sail Middle part light breeze at 6 PM made sail at 9 PM saw two whale boats the Hunter loaded Boat and was that struck with Boat put two boat men who saved the loaded Boat whale at 12 PM took the whale to the ship and was left by the South Long 18 25 30

Thursday Oct the 1st

Three 24 hours came with light breeze from the Southward at 1 PM began cutting at 4 PM finished and let the main topgallant Middle part light breeze at 6 PM made sail at 7 PM saw whale boat the Boat entered and that Boat put one each at 8 PM finished the whale to the ship and left by the South Long 18 25 30

Friday Oct the 2nd

Three 24 hours came with light breeze and long sea on at one PM began cutting at 6 PM finished and let the main topgallant Middle part light breeze at 6 PM let the main topgallant topsails and short sail latter part strong gale left by the South Long 18 25 30

Continued 1840

Sunday Sept the 4

Three 24 hours came with strong gales from the westward ship under all sail topsails all hands employed on topgallant sail at 5 PM took in sail and let the main topgallant topsails in light Middle part light breeze left part strong gale left by the South Long 18 25 30

Monday Sept the 5

Three 24 hours strong gales from the SE all hands employed on steering downwind Middle part strong gales at 6 PM began steering old sails first main topgallant at 8 PM by the South Long 18 25 30

Tuesday Oct the 6

Three 24 hours came with moderate breeze from the SE and long sea on first 11 steering down at 6 PM Shorten sail ship and to the SE Middle part light breeze at 6 PM made sail and then South saw whale boat did not get past at 10 AM saw whale boat did not strike latter part strong breeze left by the South Long 18 25 30

Wednesday Oct the 7

Three 24 hours came with light breeze from the westward ship under all sail by the wind saw whale boat did not strike saw sail in sight at 6 PM Shorten sail Middle part light breeze at 6 PM made sail saw number of whale going East to the westward to end left by the South Long 18 25 30

Thursday Oct the 8

Three 24 hours came with fine breeze and fine weather ship under all sail steering to the SE at 3 PM saw in light saw the Hunter loaded Boat put one at 4 PM began cutting got the strong gale Middle part fine weather at 4 PM finished cutting latter part end left by the South Long 18 25 30
