Jan. 1836 January A.D. 1836 Remarks

- 15 Left Valley at 29. A.M. arrived in Dublin at 11. A.M.
- 17 Went to visit Mr. Watkins
- 21 Went to visit Mr. C. Hodge
- 23 Went to visit Rev. Mr. Mullock
- 25 Left Dublin for Sheet at 8. A.M. On this night was robbed of coat and 10⁰ by two ruffians unknown
- 26 Arrived at 2.11 P.M.
- 30 Left it at 4 P.M. and arrived at Mr. Dandies at 5. Left it at 6 in the gig to Mullingar arrived in said place at 8.7 took the coach to Dublin started at 8.5. Arrived at 7.1. A.M.

- Feb. 4 Signed with B. Hill & Co. for my passage in Ship Herman to New York.
- 5 Sailed in Steamer Baltimore from North Wall at 10.2. A.M.
- 6 Arrived in Liverpool at 1.1. A.M.
- 10 Had a visit from Francis Higgins. Francis returned on this evening.
- 15 Sailed in company with other ships at 7.1. A.M. Troubled with sea sickness
- 22 Saw a sail and Grampus
- 25 Very rugged weather
- March 6 Made Cove at 5.1. A.M. Viz. a Western Island
- 10 Passengers scarce among the passengers
- 15 Bought of the Ship Broad and Awest
- April 5 Came to an anchor in the Narrows
- 6 Anchored in New York at 2.0. A.M.
