New Bedford December 1839

- Wed. 11 Remained on board, as Ship keeper
had some friends, who came off
to see me at 11 P.M. Steamboat
Telegraph took us in tow up to Hazard
Wharf got her fast alongside at 12
- Thurs 12 Very wet - rose early and then jumped
in. I have went to board South
Patrick Street North Water Street
- Frid. 13 On board on Duty
- Sat. 14 As yesterday
- Sun. 15 Snowed very hard
- Mon. 16 On board
- Tues. 17 Began to discharge cargo
- Wedn. 18 As yesterday
- Thurs 19 Went to board with Mr. May Paul
L. G. West Street
- Frid. 20 Finished Discharging
- Sat. 21 Gauging the oil and filling
- Sun. 22 A fine day
- Mon. 23 On board filling
- Tuesd. 24 Gauging and filling
- Wednes. 25 Went on a Highing party to
Rocky Mounting house
- Thurs 26 Repacking here
- Frid. 27 Filling oil gauging
- Sat. 28 Filling gauging
- Sun. 29 A wet day Snowy
- Mon. 30 Filling and gauging
- Tues. 31 Filling and gauging
