Saturday July 10th day 1841

This 24 hours with fine wind and weather
all hands employed haying at 12 fennish logs
so ends this 24 hours the first whail

Lat 38° 03' N Long 29° 16' West

Sunday July 11th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from
the North all sail out steering up to the
land all this 24 hours so ends this day

Lat 38° 13' N Long 29° 06' West

Monday July 12th day 1841

This 24 hours with light winds from the North
all sail out in the morn standing West
middle and later the swim so ends this 24 hours

Lat 38° 54' N Long 29° 06' West

Tuesday July 13th day 1841

head light winds from the East
all sail out all this 24 hours so ends

Lat 38° 18' N Long 29° 06' West

Wednesday July 14th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from
the E. N. E. at 2 P.M. took a launch long side
and put 10.90 gallons of sperm oil and sent it
on shore at 4 P.M. took our last ship and stored
West middle part fresh winds and overcast
later part moderate steering West employed senting
up four top galant mast and setting up rigging

Thursday July 15th day 1841

This 24 hours begins strong winds from the N. E.
all sail out steering S by East middle
and later much the swim so ends this 24 hours

Lat 35° 42' N Long 26° 51' West

Friday July 16th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from
S East steering S by East middle and later
fine weather so ends this 24 hours short days work

Lat 33° 01' N Long 26° 06' West

Saturday July 17th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from
the S E steering S by East with all sail out
middle and later part the swim so ends this 24 hours

Lat 31° 21' N Long 29° 13' West

Sunday July 18th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from
the S E steering South all this 24 hours
so ends this 24 hours Jacob H. Parker

Lat 27° 12' N Long 29° 41' West

Monday July 19th day 1841

This 24 hours fine winds and weather from
the N East steering South middle and
later part the swim so ends this 24 hours

Lat 26° 08' N Long 23° 25' West

Tuesday July 20th day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from the N East
steering S by West with all sail out all this 24 hours

Lat 23° 06' N Long 23° 18' West

Wednesday July 21st day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong winds
from the N East steering S by West middle
and later part fine so ends this 24 hours

Lat 22° 26' N Long 23° 18' West

Thursday July 22nd day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the
N East steering South by West all sail out
all this 24 hours so ends this 24 hours
