

Remarks On Board Ship

Friday July 23rd day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds sailing South at 12 kt left the ship to the wind to the Eastward at day light the Island of Saub in sight 18 miles dist saw 2 sail at 10 A.M. the east point 5 miles off so ends this 24 hours

Saturday July 24th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds and fine weather from the N East steering E by S at sunset 2 sail in sight middle part fore masted later part the same so ends this 24 hours

Sunday July 25th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds from the N East steering S E by S with all sail out middle part light winds later part wind from the North so ends this 24 hours

Monday July 26th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds and baffin at 2 P.M. sail a sail steering to the N East middle part calm later part light winds and baffin so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday July 27th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds and baffin middle part calm later part slight wind and baffin so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday July 28th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds and calms middle with rain middle part strong winds from the West ends with strong winds and rain

Gratitude In The Atlantic Ocean

Thursday July 29th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the West with rain steering South middle and later part like same so ends this 24 hours

Friday July 30th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the W West steering South middle part drily and rainy wind S West and squally ship heading S East so continues

Saturday July 31st day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the W West and squalls of rain middle part more pleasant ship heading S E by E later part much the same so ends this 24 hours

Sunday August 1st day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather wind S West ship heading S East with all sail out middle and later much the same so ends this 24 hours

Monday August 2nd day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S S West ship heading S E with all sail out all this 24 hours so ends this day

Tuesday Aug 3rd day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds from the South ship heading S E by East with all sail out this 24 hours so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday Aug 4th day 1841

is sailing in the Atlantic Ocean from the Cape of Good Hope to the Cape of Hope
