Wednesday August 4th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.W. at 12 took ship W. S. West saw a Duck Brig so ends this 24 hours so ends

Lat 30° N Long 15° 21' West

Thursday August 5th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light wind from the S. East saw a sail this 24 hours so ends

Lat 30° 10' N Long 16° 40' West

Friday August 6th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light winds from the South all sail out at 5 P.M. saw 4 boats for blackfish and got 1 saw a sail middle and later part the same so ends this 24 hours

Lat 12° 1' N Long 11° 05' West

Saturday August 7th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine wind from the South Ship heading W. S. W. with all sail out middle and later fine so ends this 24 hours

Lat 0° 24' N Long 20° 48' West

Sunday August 8th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light winds from the S.E. the much improved looking the blackfish made 3 bbls middle part fine later part the same so ends this 24 hours

Lat 0° 42' S Long 22° 08' West

Monday August 9th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine winds from the S.E. steering S.W. saw a Bark steering to the North pleasant then the night at 7 P.M. saw a bark steering North so ends

Lat 2° 22' S Long 23° 38' W

Tuesday August 10th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine winds from the S.E. steering S.W. saw a bark steering North so ends this 24 hours

Lat 4° 19' North Long 24° 36' West

Wednesday August 11th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light winds from the S.E. steering S.W. saw a hump back mottle and later pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Lat 6° 00' S Long 26° 40' West

Thursday August 12th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light winds from the S.E. steering S.W. middle and later the same so ends this 24 hours

Lat 7° 22' S Long 28° 19' West

Friday August 13th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering on the north to the S.W. at 11 A.M. saw a Brig steering to the north so ends this 24 hours

Lat 8° 40' S Long 29° 35' West

Saturday August 14th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering S.W. with all sail out so ends this 24 hours

Lat 10° 44' S Long 30° 16' West

Sunday August 15th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering S.W. at 7 P.M. double reefed the top sails so ends this 24 hours

Lat 12° 32' S Long 31° 25' West

Monday August 16th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering S.W. all this 24 hours so ends this 24 hours Jacob M. Parker

Lat 14° 53' S Long 32° 14' West

Tuesday August 17th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.E. steering S.W. saw fir backs so ends
