Saturday August 28th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather
all five boats and hump backs middle and
later fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Sat 18.12 S Long 36.45 West
Monday August 29th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather
at sunset shortened sail 3 sail in sight
monsoon then the night at day light single
sail 1 ship in sight so ends this 24 hours

Sat 18.13 S Long 36.54 West
Monday August 30th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather
at sunset shortened sail 1 ship in sight pleasant
then the night later part fine so ends this 24 hours

Sat 18.14 S Long 36.46 West
Tuesday August 31st day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine weather sun
finbacks hump backs and hiders at sun set
shortened sail 2 sail in sight squally then the
night at sunrise made sail 1 sail in sight
later part strong winds so ends this 24 hours

Sat 18.00 S Long 36.42 West
Wednesday Sept 1st day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds
from the South at sunset shortened sails
2 ship in sight squally then the night
later part the same 1 ship in sight
so ends with squalls this day is past

Sat 18.45 S Long 36.32 West
Thursday Sept 2nd day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the
South at sunset 1 sail in sight squally then
the night so continues this 24 hours so ends
Sat 17.36 S Long 36.15 West

On the Banks Cruisin

Friday Sept 3rd day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds
from the East sail hump backs middle
and later strong winds at day light 1 sail
in sight so ends this 24 hours

Sat 18.26 S Long 36.09 West
Saturday Sept 4th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant
weather sun hump backs at sunset shortened
sail ship heading SE with pleasant then the
night so ends with fine weather dawn

Sat 16.00 S Long 35.48 West
Sunday Sept 5th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with light winds
and rainy weather middle part more pleasant
at day light 3 sail in sight so ends this 24 hours
Sat 18.06 S Long 36.58 West

Monday Sept 6th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine weather plenty
of hump backs in sight at sunset 2 sail
in sight at day light 1 ship in sight
later part fine so ends this 24 hours
Sat 18.00 S Long 36.58 West

Tuesday Sept 7th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from
the East at sunset 1 ship in sight pleasant
then the night at 4 A.M. saw a large sparrow
whail for the boats saw him rising and
that was all came on board and sat to the
south saw nothing more so ends this 24 hours
Sat 17.45 S Long 35.59 West

Wednesday Sept 8th day 1841
this 24 hours begins with fine weather at sunset shortened sail
and S.S.C. pleasant then the night at day light 1
sail in sight so ends this day Sat 17.58 S Long 35.56
