This 24 hours begins with fine weather standing to the South at sunset shortened sail & sail in sight at sunrise & sail in sight middle and later stood to the N East so ends this 24 hours

Friday Sept 10<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine weather employed looking out the main hatch for birds and rigging at sunset shortened sail ship heading S E by S several sail in sight middle and later pleasant saw nothing so ends this 24 hours

Lat 16,21 S Long 35,35 West

Saturday Sept 11<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather from the North at sunset & sail in sight middle part wind N East at sunrise & sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Lat 15,44 S Long 34,53 West

Sunday Sept 12<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine winds from the N East at sunset & sail in sight middle part wind N East at sunrise & sail in sight so ends this 24 hours

Lat 15,46 S Long 34,39 West

Monday Sept 13<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather saw a ship from at sunset shortened sail at sunrise made sail later part pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Lat 15,00 S Long 34,45 West

Tuesday Sept 14<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine wind from the S East at sunset shortened sail middle and later fine so ends this 24 hours Lat 14,13 Long 35,03 West

This 24 hours begins with fine wind and weather from the East at sunset shortened sail at sunrise made sail a gin middle and later pleasant so ends this 24 hours saw a Bark steering

Thursday Sept 16<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine weather employed looking out the main hatch for birds at sunset shortened sail bent fore and main top sails pleasant through the night at sunrise made sail and steered S S West so ends this 24 hours

Lat 15,13 S Long 35,38 West

Friday Sept 17<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from the North at 4 o'clock spoke a brig bound to Montevideo at sunset shortened sail and have to pass the night at day light commenced looking out the and putting the oil into water part saw a sail so ends this 24 hours

Lat 15,44 S Long 34,53 West

Saturday Sept 18<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from the East employed steering down oil at sunset finished short sail through the night & sail in sight later part wind made sail and steered N East wind S S W so ends this 24 hours this day is part and all well

Lat 15,50 S Long 35,53 West

Sunday Sept 19<sup>th</sup> day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine wind and weather from the North steering S S W with all sail out all this 24 hours so ends this 24 hours
