

Remarks On Board Ship Latitude

Monday Sept ^{the} 20 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from the North steering SSW with all sail out middle and later fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours steering SSW

Lat 21 53 North Long 41 26 West

Tuesday Sept 21 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds from the South steering SSW with all sail out middle and later part Ship heading S on the wind so ends this 24 hours Lat 20 40 S Long 41 26 West

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Wednesday Sept 22 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light winds from the SSW at sunset thick and overcast shortened sail at day light made sail saw a Ship steering to the North so ends this 24 hours

Lat 20 40 S Long 41 26 West

Thursday Sept 23 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with light wind from the N East steering SSW with all sail out light rain at 6 AM wind from the South and heavy and rain heavy took in all sail but close reefed main topsail and foresail at 10 AM more moderate rain sail gradually at 12 all sail out Ship heading SSW so ends this 24 hours

Lat 20 10 S Long 41 45 West

Friday Sept 24 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the SSW Ship heading SSW with all sail out at 2 at night took Ship heading SSW at day light took to the S at 10 AM saw a sail to the windward so ends this 24 hours in the Atlantic

Lat 19 28 South Long 39 40 West

from the Solas towards Cape Horn

Saturday Sept 25 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from the SSW Ship heading SSW with all sail out first part part four sail at 12 kt the wind from the East steering SSW later part part four and main topsails so ends this 24 hours

Lat 24 23 South Long 40 26 West

Sunday September 26 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with a fine wind from the N East steering SSW with all sail out nothing more remarkable this 24 hours so ends

Lat 26 03 S Long 41 27 West

Monday Sept 27 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds from the N East steering SSW with all sail out later part took in the fore part saw breeches so ends this 24 hours

Lat 27 44 South Long 42 28 West

Tuesday Sept 28 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds from the North steering SSW with all sail out middle part moderate sun for hours later part wind from the South and S East and black on strong took in all sail but close reefed topsails and foresail rainy all the later part so ends this 24 hours

Lat 28 20 South Long 42 55 West

Wednesday Sept 29 day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S East Ship heading SSW at four and main spruce and main sail and reefed spruce middle part more rainy the later part more pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Lat 30 08 S Long 44 17 West
