

Remarks on board Ship Gratitude

Thursday Sept 30 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with strong winds from  
the East steering S 8 West with double reefed  
middle part main & East so ends with strong  
winds and quite cool for the latitude

Lat 32 52 S Long 46 34 West

Friday October 1 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with strong gales  
from the East steering S 8 West took in  
main sail and close reefed the top sails  
and took in the main boat tarp and  
raining thru the night at 10 bells decked reefed  
the m top sail so ends this 24 hours thick weather

Lat 35 17 S Long 48 12 West

Saturday October 2 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins more mile from  
the N.W. steering S 8 West at 2 5 the sat  
the m sail let a reef out the fore and  
main top sail and set main top of sail  
middle part light wind from the West  
later part light wind from the North  
so ends this 24 hours Ship Gratitude

Lat 35 52 S Long 48 39 West

Sunday October 3 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with a fine breeze  
from the N East steering S 7 by S with  
all sail out saw a ship steering S 8 West  
by 10 ht got us under close reefed strong  
gale from S 8 W at 12 more moderate  
so ends

Lat 36 34 S Long 49 20 West

Monday Oct 4 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with heavy gales from the S East  
Ship heading S W under close reefed top sails at 3 took  
in all sail but close reefed main top sail and  
Spencer's ship heading E S E lying to Lat 36 52 Long 49 47

Bound Round Cape Horn

Tuesday Oct 5 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with strong gales from  
the South Ship heading E S East with close  
reef main top sail and fore and main  
Spencer middle part more moderate made  
dum sail thru the night later part made  
all sail so ends this 24 hours

Lat 36 41 S Long 49 32 West

Wednesday October 6 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with light breeze  
from the S East Ship heading S West  
with all sail out middle part pleasant  
and later the sun so ends this 24 hours

Lat 37 57 S Long 51 25 West

Thursday Oct 7 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with fine winds and  
weather from the East steering S 7 by S  
with all sail out at sunset sounded 120  
fathoms no bottom micke and later fine weather  
so ends this 24 hours fine pleasant weather

Lat 39 01 S Long 52 53 West

Friday October 8 day 1841  
this 24 hours begins with light winds from the S East  
steering S 7 by S with all sail out saw a right  
whale and plenty of porpoises this day it and the  
Coptin snape beds middle of later fine so ends

Lat 40 56 South Long 54 29 West

Saturday 9 Lat 40 56 South Long 54 29 West  
this 24 hours begins with strong breeze from  
the West steering S 8 W saw right whales  
and porpoises strong winds thru the night at  
day light took in main top of main sail and  
jib and spraker mainsail and double reefed  
fore top sail and close reefed the main  
and fore the main top sail so ends

Lat 43 21 Long 57 38 S
