Sunday Novth 7th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with winds from the N.W. & S.W.
Ship heading West with all sail out with thick
fog and rain middle part wind S.W. more ship to
the N.W. and sat foremast top mast steering sail
with a fair wind and more later part fine and
pleasant so ends this 24 hours in the

Lat 54 41 S Long 83 00 W

Monday Novth 8th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather
steering N.W. with all sail out middle
part wind W by S and pleasant thru the night
later part painted the mast boat so ends the 24 hours

Lat 52 20 South Long 82 30 W

Tuesday Novth 9th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine wind and weather from the
W.S.W. steering N.W. with all sail out watch
in flood fishing spurs and clearing the decks
and back the cutting foremast a left and painted the
mast boat wind W.S.W. so ends this 24 hours

in Lat 50 40 South Long 82 00 W

Wednesday Novth 10th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds and pleasant weather
from the W.S.W. steering N.W. with all sail
out middle and later strong winds and light squalls
so ends this 24 hours with light winds

Lat 47 23 South Long 81 30 W

Thursday Novth 11th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from
the S.W. steering N.W. all this 24 hours with all
sail out so ends this 24 hours fine and pleasant

Lat 45 04 South Long 80 26 W

Friday Novth 12th

this 24 hours begins with
fine winds from the S.W. steering N.W. with all sail out later part
thick fog and light rain so ends in Lat 42 12 S Long 80 00 W

from Cape Horn Down the Coast 1841

Saturday November 13th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with storm winds and pleasant
weather from S.W. steering N.W. with all sail
out middle and later part fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours in the

Lat 39 42 South Long 77 35 W

Sunday November 14th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine wind from the S.W. & S
saw a long breach ran for it saw nothing more
later part sun rain the 24 hours ends pleasant

in the Lat 37 43 S Long 78 44 W

Monday Novth 15th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S.S.E.
steering N.W. with all sail out saw a whales
carcasses pleasant thru the night at day light
saw a sail steering to the north so ends this 24 hours

in the Lat 35 42 S Long 78 49 W

Tuesday Novth 16th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from
the South steering N.W. first part sent
up fore and main top gallant mast and yards
and sent out fly jib boom pleasant thru the
night at day light the Island of Lundy 10 mi
off later part sent up the fore and main
sails so ends this 24 hours pleasant

in the Lat 33 44 S Long 78 49 W

Wednesday November 17th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine wind from the South
steering N.W. with all sail out at sunset
the island 30 miles off saw plenty
blackfish middle and later fine and
pleasant so ends this 24 hours
in the Lat 32 03 South Long 77 35 W
