

Remarks On board Ship Gratitude

Thursday Nov 18 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant weather from the South steering N by E all hands and boat sails pleasant thru the night at day light saw sperm whales land 4 boats the whails going quick to the windward at 10 o'clock took up the boats and stood on the wind to the N East until 12 the. Sailed our course so ends this day in Lat 30.44 South Long 77.47 West

Friday Nov 19 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the South steering South with all sail out much in flood mending sails made part fine later finish mending and bent them. so ends this 24 hours in

Lat 29.22 South Long 77.37 West

Saturday Nov 20 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light wind from the South steering North saw finbacks watch in flood rising up and sails later part broke out for empty cask so ends this 24 hours in the

Lat 28.43 South Long 77.25 West

Sunday Nov 21 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the South steering North all this 24 hours saw finbacks and blackfish so ends this 24 hours

Lat 26.22 S Long 77.23 West

Monday Nov 22 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds from S East steering N all this day at day light commenced making out between decks and finish the day

Lat 23.59 S Long 77.22 West

Tuesday Nov 23 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine winds from S E steering N at 5 o'clock finish mending down the board later finish mending commencing turning down the rigging so ends Lat 21.42 S Long 77.21 West

On the Coast of Peru in 1841

Wednesday Nov 24 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with strong trade steering South all this day broke out for hemp line much in flood during rigging saw a sail steering to the East later part clear and pleasant so ends this 24 hours Lat 12.50 S Long 77.25 West

Thursday Nov 25 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds and pleasant weather much in flood during rigging and the iron work mended thru the night later fine winds so ends this 24 hours in the Lat 15.45 S Long 77.38 West

Friday Nov 26 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with light winds steering North by West watch in flood in ship's duty saw finbacks and porpoises so ends this 24 hours in the

Lat 17.28 S Long 77.24 West

Saturday Nov 27 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine trade steering North pleasant thru the night later saw finbacks and a caracal and blackfish so ends this 24 hours

Lat 17.19 S Long 77.19 West

Sunday Nov 28 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine trade from the S East steering North saw finbacks pleasant thru the night at day light spoke ship Soucohuenter of Lixhuang with 3 whails a long side saw several sail the later part of this 24 hours

Lat 14.06 South Long 77.18 West

Sunday Nov 29 day 1841

This 24 hours begins with fine trade and pleasant weather at 3 o'clock saw a school of sperm whales land but did not strike for they were scared by the ship at sunset shorten sail at day light saw them a gain land and got nothing began to stand boats makes four several ships so ends this 24 hours Lat 14.02 S Long 77.18 West
