

Remarks on board Ship

Saturday Dec 11th day 1841

this 24 hours fine weather all hands and board met the moon that merrily but ship another later part all ready for sea with our staff sails lost and bore 500 t. so ends this 24 hours

Sunday December 12th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather at 2 P.M. took the anchor and put to sea got clear of the head and shorten sail at day light 2 rocks in sight and a brig standing in for the land saw pinbacks so ends this 24 hours

Monday Dec 13th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine wind ship heading of shore later part saw blackfish and 2 boats and got nothing so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday Dec 14th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine pleasant weather all the day saw nothing so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday Dec 15th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather saw several ships in course of the day midland later fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Thursday Dec 16th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from the S East steering to the South and West all this 24 hours midland and later fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Gratitude on Sea in 1841

Friday Dec 17th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. took ship to the East midland and later part pleasant saw nothing so ends this 24 hours

Saturday Dec 18th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds at 2 P.M. took ship to the S and West at sunset took to the East pleasant thru the night later the swim so ends

Sunday Dec 19th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine wind and weather from the S East at 2 P.M. spoke ship Ganges of Sanducket 4 1/2 months out 200 blks percent thru the night took ship 2 or 3 times this 24 hours so ends this 24 hours

Monday Dec 20th day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine winds and weather from the S East evening a boat and saw nothing so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday Dec 21st day 1841

this 24 hours begins fine weather at sunset squared the yards and steered N.W. at 10 A.M. saw a Brigee steering to the East ropes that she was bound in to Calico so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday Dec 22nd day 1841

this 24 hours begins with fine weather steering N.W. saw 2 ships steering the South midland later fine and pleasant later part fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours

Thursday Dec 23rd day 1841

this 24 hours with fine winds and weather steering N.W. all this day fine weather saw nothing so ends this 24 hours
