This 24 hours begins with fine weather steering W by S with all sail out middle and later saw rain saw nothing in so ends this 24 hours

Friday January 10<sup>th</sup> day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine wind and weather steering W by S at sunset shortened sail and heft to the wind to the south saw a ship standing to the south so ends this 24 hours

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S East ship heading S West at day light more ship to the S E saw nothing so ends this 24 hours

This 24 hours begins with strong winds from the S East steering N East middle and later fine and pleasant so ends this 24 hours
