

Remarks on board Ship

Thursday March 10th 1842

this 24 hours begins with squally and rainy weather at sunset took in all sail but in topsail and fore-sail at daylight made sail and steered W by S wind light and baffled and rainy so ends this 24 hours in the

Friday March 11th day 1842 this 24 hours begins with light winds and thick weather steering N by E at sunset in sail and lights to the south at day light made sail and steered W by S same fore-backs so ends this 24 hours in the

Saturday March 12th 1842 this 24 hours begins with light wind at 5 P.M. saw the E end of Anice then steered N by W then the night at 8 bells saw the end of Anice and ran for it so ends this 24 hours in the

Sunday March 13th 1842 this 24 hours begins with fine breeze at 5 P.M. got up with the East end of Anice at 7 shortened sail and hove to there the night at day light made sail and steered for the harbor but did not reach this 24 hours so ends this day

Monday March 14th 1842 this 24 hours begins with light wind and baffled at 2 P.M. saw the ships lying at an anchor in the harbor braced around the yard 100 times at 7 P.M. the Pilot came on board at 11 P.M. light came to an anchor at 2 P.M. the pilot went ashore later found in flood securing ship and blacking the leads so ends this 24 hours

Tuesday March 15th this 24 hours begins with moderate wind and verables employ blacking leads and painting ship so ends this 24 hours

Wednesday March 16th 1842

this 24 hours fine weather employ painting at sunset saw 2 ships in the passage later part saw 2 more working in to the bay one much on liberty so ends

Thursday 17th 1842

this day fine weather one much on shore the other in flood getting of recruits so ends this day

Friday 18th day 1842

this day fine weather 3 ships went sea to day and 2 came in one much on shore the other getting of recruits so ends

Saturday 19th 1842

this day fine thick rainy w one much on shore so ends thick rainy one much on shore nothing doing this day

Sunday 20th 1842 this day

Monday 21st 1842 this day one much on liberty other employ getting of recruits

Tuesday 22nd this day sun

Wednesday 23rd this day employ getting of recruits w one much on liberty the other getting recruits on board

Thursday 24th this day fine

Friday 25th 1842 this day fine pleasant w one much on liberty so ends

Saturday 26th this day

fine weather one much on liberty the other employ getting ready for sea so ends this day

Sunday 27th this day begins with

calms at 7 bells got under way but had to be anchored again at 10 took the anchor and part sea so ends

Monday 28th in the year of our Lord 1842

this day
