Thursday May ^{the} 12 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine weather at sunset in sail to the West thick fog thru the night later more pleasant

so ends in the Sat ^{the} 13 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with light winds from the East sun heavy at sunset in sail at daylight made sail and steered S by W later morn'nt saw a finback so ends this day

in Sat ^{the} 14 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and pleasant weather in flood breaking out for water at sunset in sail at daylight made sail and steered S by W so ends this day

in Sat ^{the} 15 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine wind from the S steering to the West at sunset in sail middle thick and rainy later heavy wind and rain so ends this 24 hours

in Sat ^{the} 16 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with heavy winds and rainy weather ship heading to the S under close reef main topsail at sunset in four sail blew a heavy gale thru the night later more morn'nt so ends this day

in Sat ^{the} 17 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with heavy gales and clear weather middle sat four sail fore and main topsail ship heading S by W later more pleasant sun over east in foggy wind at boat

in Sat ^{the} 18 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with strong winds and fine rain at sunset in sail more pleasant ship heading S by E later made sail thick and foggy saw finbacks so ends this 24 hours

Thursday May ^{the} 19 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with thick foggy weather steering to the West at sunset in sail rainy thru the night later part pleasant wind North steering S by W saw finback and

in Sat ^{the} 20 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine breeze and pleasant weather steering S by W at sunset in sail and left to the wind to the West at daylight made sail and steered S by W saw finbacks so ends

in Sat ^{the} 21 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and pleasant weather at sunset in sail at daylight made all sail and steered West so ends

in Sat ^{the} 22 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine winds from the S by W at 5 P.M. came on thick and foggy at sunset in all sail but four sail and reef main topsail took ship to the S by E later more pleasant made run sail and steered S by W by S wind from it to East so ends

in Sat ^{the} 23 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with light winds and rainy weather at sunset in all sail and left to the S by E at daylight more pleasant made sail and stood on the wind to the S by W

in Sat ^{the} 24 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and smoky weather steering on the wind to the S and W at sunset in sail at daylight made sail and took ship to the S by E sun gumpfused

in Sat ^{the} 25 day 1842

This 24 hours begins with fine winds and pleasant weather from the S by E at sunset in sail at daylight made sail at 10 A.M. took ship middle and later morn'nt saw a sparrow drift and coat a shark so ends this 24 hours in Sat ^{the} 26 day 1842
