Wednesday Sept 21 day 1842

this 24 hours light winds and pleasant weather from the East at sunset
shorten sail at daylight made sail saw a ship to the East of us
in Sat S. Lang East

Thursday Sept 22 day 1842

this 24 hours light winds and fine weather from the East to
later part spoke ship Sarah and Frances of Fairhaven
33 months out 1400 bls took ship to the East all sail out
all this 24 hours Sat S. Lang East

Friday Sept 23 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with fine and pleasant weather from the East
at 4 P.M. took ship to the East by S later part strong wind
saw a ship Sat S. Lang East

Saturday Sept 24 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with strong wind and squally weather first
part reef the topsails at sunset in four and misen topsail
heavy squalls of wind and rain later part Sat double
reef S topsail ship heading NW so ends this 24 hours
Sat S. Lang East

Sunday Sept 25 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with strong gales at sunset in four
topsail at daylight set it a gain so ends this 24 hours
Sat S. Lang East

Monday Sept 26 day 1842

this 24 hours strong gales from the East at 1 P.M. in four topsail
saw a ship to the windward later part set four topsail and mainmast
and none ship heading up East so ends this 24 hours
in Sat S. Lang East

Tuesday Sept 27 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with strong winds from the East by the
ship under double reefs at daylight saw a ship to the windward
under short sail so ends strong winds
in Sat S. Lang East

From Japan To the Sandwich Islands

Wednesday Sept 28 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with strong wind from the East at sunset close
reef and none ship to the East by S at daylight made some sail
and with 18 wind Sat S. Lang East

Thursday Sept 29 day 1842

this 24 hours strong winds from the East at sunset more ship to the
East at 11 A.M. saw 3 ships in a gam later part strong wind 3
ships in sight Sat S. Lang East

Friday Sept 30 day 1842

this 24 hours strong winds from the East at sunset in mainmast ship heading
N by W in place mending sails at 12 took ship to the East South
in Sat S. Lang East

Saturday October 1 day 1842

this 24 hours fine wind from the East first part took ship at 1 P.M.
later part in morning calm saw 3 ships so ends the 24 hours
Sat S. Lang East

Sunday Oct 2 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with moderate wind ship heading E by S
middle and later wind NW course E by N in place setting up rigging
Sat S. Lang East

Monday Oct 3 day 1842

this 24 hours light winds from the East by the ship heading East
later moderate wind and calm so ends this 24 hours in the
Sat S. Lang East

Tuesday Oct 4 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with light wind from the East strong East by
S middle part morning calm later part light and hazy
from all parts of the compass saw nothing this 24 hours
Latitude North Tropic West

Wednesday Oct 5 day 1842

this 24 hours legends with this day commenced standing half masts
in place setting up rigging later repaired four sail
so ends this 24 hours in the
Sat S. Lang West
