Tuesday January 10 day 1843

this 24 hours thick rainy weather and bafflin wind and light
all the 24 hours in Sat S Long West

Wednesday Jan 11 day 1843

this 24 hours began light wind and rainy weather later part
fine breeze from the S.E. and quite pleasant so end

Thursday Jan 12 day 1843

this 24 hours with a fine breeze from the S.E. took ship
to the E. middle and later wind from all parts of the compass

Friday Jan 13 day 1843

this 24 hours light wind and bafflin and some rain took
ship 2 or 3 times this 24 hours so end

Saturday Jan 14 day 1843

this 24 hours light wind and bafflin first part took ship
to the E. middle took to the S.W. later part cloudy and rainy

Sunday Jan 15 day 1843

this 24 hours light wind from the E.S.E. with fog and rain
ship heading S.W. later more pleasant and man sick
of duty

Monday Jan 16 day 1843

this 24 hours brisk breeze from the S.E. ship heading E. middle
and later to the S.W. end fine and pleasant

Tuesday January 17 day 1843

this 24 hours fine breeze from the S.E. ship heading E. by S.
end fine and pleasant

Wednesday January 18 day 1843

this 24 hours fresh breeze from the S.E. took ship 2 or 3 times
this 24 hours in Sat S Long West

Thursday Jan 19 day 1843

this 24 hours fine breeze from the S.E. took ship several times this 24 hours
Sat S Long West

On The Offshore Ground in 1843

Friday Jan 20 day 1843

this 24 light winds and pleasant weather sunset took ship to the
N.E. S.W. in Sat S Long West

Saturday Jan 21 day 1843

this 24 hours fine clouds from the S.E. at sunset commence standing
boats makes so end Sat 10.12 S Long 101.00 West

Sunday Jan 22 day 1843

this 24 hours fine clouds standing to the S.W. all this 24 hours
so end this 24 hours Sat S Long West

Monday Jan 23 day 1843

this 24 hours light wind and foggy weather middle and later the
same so end in the Sat S Long West

Tuesday Jan 24 day 1843

this 24 hours light clouds and overcast weather later light equals
of rain so end this 24 hours Sat S Long West

Wednesday Jan 25 day 1843

this 24 hours light wind at daylight load 3 boats for blackfish
and got 3 i ask the second man to let me have mine
on the boat and he send he work so me dan first
so ends this 24 hours Sat S Long West

Thursday Jan 26 day 1843

this 24 hours fine clouds standing to the S.W. later in place
laying blackfish so end Sat S Long West

Friday Jan 27 day 1843

this 24 hours strong wind at sunset double reef at daylight
but the mainsail standing to the S.W. all this 24 hours
so end this day Sat S Long West

Saturday Jan 28 day 1843

this 24 hours strong wind from the S.E. heading S.W. under easy sail so end
at 18.00 Sat S Long West

Sunday Jan 29 day 1843

this 24 hours strong winds at daylight made all sail and
steered of N.W. rain nothing Sat S Long West

Monday Jan 30 day 1843

this 24 hours strong wind at sunset held to the S.E. at day
steered of N.W. so end Sat S Long West
