Tuesday January 31 day 1843

this 24 hours fine birds at 4 P.M. were up 1 P.M. at sunset in
with the light sails at daylight made all sail and steered
1843 & saw nothing so end Lat S Gang West

Wednesday February 1 day 1843

this 24 this day fine mind and pleasant weather from the S &
steering force so end Lat S Gang West

Thursday Feb 2 day 1843

this 24 fine mind and pleasant weather steering NW by S and
this 24 hours in Lat S Gang West

Friday Feb 3 day 1843

this 24 hours light mind and pl weather from the S & steering NW by S
S Gang West

Saturday Feb 4 day 1843

this 24 hours at 2 P.M. were ship on steered S W by S
end fine and pleasant saw a finback Lat S Gang West

Sunday Feb 5 day 1843

this 24 hours fine mind and pleasant weather steering to the S W
all this 24 hours Lat S Gang West

Monday Feb 6 day 1843

this 24 hours fine weather at 2 P.M. saw a large sperm
whale lord 3 boats the bow boat struck and
killed at 4 P.M. took him to the ship and
commence buting at dark lark down

at day light back on at 12 finnish and started
the marks in the Lat 64.02 South Gang West

Tuesday Feb 7 day 1843

end 24 hours strong birds in flood boiling later part
squally in force topsail so end Lat S Gang West

Wednesday Feb 8 day 1843

this 24 hours strong birds at 5 P.M. finnish boiling
and rose ship to the S & middle and later the same

so end this 24 hours New York

Latitude South Gang West

On The Offshore Ground 1843

Thursday Feb 9 day 1843

this 24 strong birds middle and later more moderate so end this 24 hours
in the Latitude South Gang West

Friday Feb 10 day 1843

this 24 hours begins with a fine breeze and pleasant weather
in flood strong down so end Lat S Gang West

Saturday Feb 11 day 1843

this 24 hours fine mind and pleasant weather first part in
flood strong down at 5 P.M. finnish later part pleasant

so end this 24 hours in the Lat S Gang West

Sunday Feb 12 day 1843

this 24 hours fine birds at sunset in main sail at daylight
set it a gain and steered S W by S Lat S Gang West

Monday Feb 13 day 1843

this 24 hours fine birds and pleasant weather from the S &
steering S W so end Lat S Gang West

Tuesday Feb 14 day 1843

this 24 hours strong birds steering S W all this 24 hours
so end this day in the Lat S Gang West

Wednesday Feb 15 day 1843

this 24 hours fine birds and pleasant weather at sunset more ship
to the S & middle and later strong birds in flood

mending the fore topsail Lat S Gang West

Thursday Feb 16 day 1843

this 24 hours fine birds and pleasant weather at sunset in
main sail at daylight made sail steering S in flood

mending main topsail in Lat S Gang West

Friday Feb 17 day 1843

this 24 hours fine mind and pleasant weather at sunset in
main sail at 4 P.M. saw a sail at 7 A.M. spoke her

the Bark Tellones of Stonington 13 months
out 600 bbls at sunset parted company with schooner

and saw a ship to the windward so end this 24
hours in the Lat S Gang West
