Tuesday March 7th day 1843

this 24 hours light winds steering N.W. by N. all this 24 hours
sun pinbacks so end in Lat 00 57. Long 134 00 00 West

Wednesday March 8th day 1843

this 24 hours light winds steering N.W. by N. sun
pinbacks in the Lat 02 02 Long 134 50 West

Thursday March 9th day 1843

this 24 hours light air and baffin later fine breeze steering
Westward Lat 02 25 Long 135 45 West

Friday March 10th day

this 24 hours fine wind and blue sun steering N.W.
in the Lat 04 04 Long 136 25 West

Saturday March 11th day 1843

this 24 hours fine wind and blue weather steering
N.W. in the Lat 06 03 Long 137 14 West

Sunday March 12th day

this 24 hours light wind and blue sun steering
in the Lat 06 38 Long 138 00 West

Monday March 13th day 1843

this 24 hours began with light wind and baffin
at sunset commencing standing half mackies
Ship of N.W. later part wind N.E. course N.W. by N.
in the Lat 06 41 Long 138 49 West

Tuesday March 14th day 1843

this 24 hours light winds from the N.E. later part
strong wind steering N.W. by N. so end this 24 hours
in the Lat 07 50 N

Wednesday March 15th day 1843

this 24 hours strong winds from the N.E. steering
N.W. so end in Lat 09 37 Long 139 48 West

Thursday March 16th day 1843

this 24 hours strong winds from the N.E. steering
N.W. sun pinbacks in the
Lat 12 26 North Long 140 45

From the off shore to the Sandrich Island

Friday March 17th day 1843

all this 24 hours strong winds steering N.W. by N. sun
pinbacks in Lat 13 39 Long 143 05 West

Saturday March 18th day 1843

all this 24 hours strong winds steering N.W. by N. sun
pinbacks so end in Lat 14 40 Long 145 00 West

Sunday March 19th day 1843

all this 24 hours light wind steering N.W. sun nothing
in the Lat 15 39 Long 146 14 West

Monday March 20th day 1843

this 24 hours light wind later nearly calm steering N.W. by N.
so end this 24 hours in the Lat 16 08 Long 147 40 West

Tuesday March 21st day 1843

this 24 hours fine breeze from the N.E. later part
strong winds steering N.W. by N. Lat 17 07 Long 148 55 West

Wednesday March 22nd day 1843

this 24 hours light wind steering N.W. Lat 17 40 Long 149 20 West

Thursday March 23rd day 1843

this 24 hours began light wind later part strong wind and
raining weather from the N. steering N.W. by N. Long 152 49 W

Friday March 24th day 1843

first part of this 24 hours strong wind from the N.E.
and raining weather middle more pleasant at 9 A.M. saw
cove then steered N.W. by N. so end this 24 hours
in the Lat 19 05 North Long 154 25 West

Saturday March 25th day 1843

first part strong wind steering along the Star South
side of the Island at sunset 30 miles of the harbor
middle and later light wind and Calms got nowhere where
the vessel lost him self Lat 19 11 N Long 155 14 W

Sunday March 26th this 24 hours light air and baffin
at 11 A.M. came to anchor in Corcoran bay

so end this 24 hours in Lat 19 25 N
