

Remarks on Board Ship

Monday June 12 day 1843
this 24 hours light winds and pl weather from the S
saw 4 ships this 24 hours Lat 27, 41 Long 166, 13 E

Tuesday 13 this 24 hours fine winds and weather
saw 7 or 8 ships this day Lat 29, 48 Long 166

Wednesday 14 this 24 hours fine
winds and pl weather first part saw 2 ships

Thursday 15 this day begins with
fine weather later part heavy rain and thunder and lightning
at 12 more pleasant Lat 30, 38 Long 166, 40 East

Friday 16 this 24 hours fine winds and pl
weather from the N E Lat 30, 14 Long 167, 00

Saturday June 17 this 24 hours
begins with fine winds and pl weather at sunset in sail
at daylight made sail at 6 AM saw a school
of sperm whales land & boat the Bow
boat struck and drove the ice chase the whales
all day and got nothing 3 ships in sight and got
a whale Lat 30, 14 Long 167, 00 East

Sunday June 18 all this 24 hours
fine winds and pleasant weather saw 4 ships this 24
hours min South Lat 30, 44 N Long 167, 01

Monday 19 this 24 fine winds and pleasant
weather saw 4 ships Lat 30, 18 Long 167, 59 East

Tuesday 20 first part strong breeze
and squalls of rain at sunset in sail 1 ship in
sight at 10 AM saw sperm whales and land

4 boats the land boat struck
83 and got upset and drove the ice the bow
boat struck and killed and parted the ice strap
but finally saw him at 6 PM took him
to the ship Lat 30, 33 Long 168, 37
31 13

Wednesday 21 this 24 hours fine weather
in place in cutting at 12 finish and commence boylung

Thursday 22 all this 24 hours in place
boylung saw 2 ship boylung and cutting

Friday 23 this 24 hours in place boylung
later part finish Lat 30, 37 N Long 167, 57 East

Saturday 24 this 24 hours fine breeze
and smoky weather later part in place and opening

Sunday 25 this 24 hours in place
storing down at 10 AM finish and made sail on pinback
Lat 30, 38 Long 168, 07 East

Monday 26 this 24 hours strong
wind and smoky weather saw nothing so end

Tuesday 27 this 24 hours strong winds and
later part rainy weather all sail in with heavy
wind and rain no sail no long

Wednesday June 28 day 1843
first part of this 24 hours heavy wind and rain
ship under close reef main topsail strong winds
and rain thru the night later more pleasant ship under

main topsail and foremast Lat 30, 43 Long 168, 11 East

Thursday 29 this 24 hours strong winds
and heavy rain all this 24 hours Lat 30, 43 Long 168, 11 East

Friday June 30 first part more moderate
made sail wind at sunset clear and pleasant later
saw a ship and pinbacks in place setting up shooles
so end this 24 hours Lat 30, 08 N Long 168, 08 East

Saturday July 1 day 1843
this 24 hours strong winds from the N E storing
to the N W later part strong wind saw a
pinback Lat 30, 58 N Long 167, 02
