Sunday July 2 day 1843

this 24 hours strong winds from the E first part
steered NW at night in sail and left to the wind to the
NE at daylight more ship to SSW so end with strong
winds in the Sat 31, 15 Long 166, 50 East

Monday 3 this 24 hours begins with
strong wind and smoky weather first part saw a
Ship later pleasant Sat 30, 58 Long 166, 10 East

Tuesday July 4 day 1843 of our land
this 24 hours strong winds from the S later part
saw 2 Ships so end Sat 30 41 Long 16

Wednesday this 24 hours begins with
strong wind and smoky m at 4 P.M.
saw Shum whales and land the

40 boats the barbed boat got one
small whale 41 bbls at look him to
the ship at 11 a clock at night at daylight
commence cutting at 10 A.M. finnish and began boiling

Thursday 6 this 24 hours in flood
boiling later finnish Sat 30, 30 Long 168, 02

Friday 7 this 24 hours fine wind and fl. weather
all this 24 hours so end Sat 30, 47 Long 167, 00

Saturday 8 this 24 hours fine weather
later part stode down 40 bbls oil in the after
hatch saw 3 Ship so end Sat 30, 48 Long 167, 24 E

Sunday 9 this 24 hours fine wind from
the SE at sunset 3 Ships in sight later part mordenit
saw a finback and land 2 boats and came a lander same
as they went Sat 30, 36 Long 167, 16 East

Monday 10 this first part
light air later part in flood boiling out
the fence hole for sharks heads the barbed
faul parled and the block came down and
cut the 2 mil head and sent a canoe
Sat 30, 28 Long 167, 37 East

this 24 hours light wind and pleasant weather saw finbacks and
Sat 30, 05 Long 167, 49 East

Wednesday 12 this 24 hours light
wind and pleasant weather from the NE later part
saw a ship Sat 30, 04 Long 167, 32 East

Thursday 13 this 24 hours light wind
and pleasant weather at 4 P.M. spoke the Bark Taron
of London and got the names of the los of the Ship
Parker on ocean island later fine and pleasant

Sat 31, 00 Long 168, 28

Friday 14 this 24 hours fine wind and fl. weather
at sunrise saw 3 Ships Sat 30, 33 Long 167, 28 East

Saturday 15 this 24 hours fine wind and fl. weather
saw a ship boiling Sat 30, 32 Long 167, 30 East

Sunday 16 this 24 hours fine wind and fl.
weather at 5 P.M. saw Shum whales land the
boats the Bone boat stuck at 11 took him
to the ship and recommence cutting the ship
Walter Scott in chase Sat 30, 28 Long

Monday 17 this 24 hours
fine wind and fl. weather from the SE
first part finnish cutting later in flood boiling
at sunset spoke the ship Walter Scott 32 more
out 1000 bbls at later part 3 Ships in sight saw 3

Sat 30, 02 Long 16

Tuesday 18 this 24 hours fine weather at 2 P.M.
saw Shum whales at 5 P.M. land got nothing
the ship m Scott in chase got nothing but saw a ship
take a whale at the leeward of our whales going
to the SW later part saw 4 Ships Sat 30, 00 Long 166, 25

Wednesday 19 this 24 hours fine wind and pleasant
weather saw 6 Ships this 24 hours so end
