

Monday Sept 4th day 1848
first part spoke the Barque Pantheon later
part fine weather saw 6 Ships so ends this 24 hours

Lat 29, 51 Long 173 31

Tuesday 5th all this day fine weather
and light wind in flood mending fore sail saw 1 Bark

Lat 30, 29 Long 174

Wednesday 6th this 24 hours began
with calm weather and so end in flood mending sails
the B S in sight Lat 30, 54 Long 173, 10 E

Thursday 7th this 24 hours began with
light wind and fine weather ends with strong wind
and rainy at 11 sail in fore and mizen topsails so end

Friday 8th this 24 hours began with
strong wind and heavy rain at sunset in fore sail
wind S E middle and later the same saw 2 Ships

Saturday 9th this 24 hours began
rainy weather rainy weather later light wind and pleasant
saw 2 sail Lat 31, 27 Long 174, 49 East

Sunday 10th this 24 hours calm weather
11 sail in sight Lat 31, 21 Long 175 00

Monday 11th this 24 hours fine weather
and light wind at sunrise the Bark seen to
the leeward saw 2 whales and sat her
Calars at 9 we saw them and lost
the waiste boat struck the whale
took the line the bow boat struck
him at 2 P.M. look him to the ship

Lat 31 19 no Long

Tuesday 12th in flood beating at 11 finish
saw the B Pantheon beating and saw 2 Ships
standing to the east in flood beating

Lat 31, 22 Long 174, 19 East

Wednesday 13th day 1848
this 24 hours fine weather in flood
beating saw 2 Ships and the B S beating

Lat 31, 08 Long 174, 45 East

Thursday 14th all this 24 hours light
wind and fine weather middle finish beating the
B S to leeward Lat 31, 03 Long 175, 10, 174, 31

Friday 15th all this 24 hours fine weather
later in flood beating Lat 30, 34 Long 174, 41

Saturday 16th this 24 hours moderate
weather later in flood strong down at 12 finish
the B S in sight Lat 30, 19 Long 174, 45 East

Sunday 17th all this 24 hours fine weather
saw a sail and finches Lat 30, 22 Long 174, 45

Monday 18th this 24 hours light wind
and squally weather saw 2 sail no 9th nor Long

Tuesday 19th this 24 hours fine
winds from the S E Lat 30, 50 Long 175 00

Wednesday 20th this 24 hours fine
winds and smoky weather from the S W
saw 2 sail Lat 31, 15 Long 174, 45

Thursday 21th this 24 hours fine
weather from the S W at 11 30 ends

Lat 31, 23 Long 176 00

Friday 22th this 24 hours fine winds
from the S W ends Lat 30, 45 Long 176, 14

Saturday 23th first part fine weather
later strong wind from the S W ship
under close reef main topsail

Sunday 24th this 24 hours began
with heavy wind and rainy weather ship
under close reef m. topsail wind S W at 11
late wind S W at sunrise sat fore sail

Lat 30 10 Long 174 32
