wind from the N.E. ship heading E.S.E. sails

Thu ^{no} 28 this 24 hours strong
wind from the N.E. at sunset took ship to the N.W.
ship under double reefs no lat no long

Fri ^{no} 29 this 24 hours strong wind
from the N.E. saw 2 ships sails Lat 30.39 Long 178.30

Sat ^{no} 30 this 24 hours strong
wind and equally weather ship under double reefs
to the N.W. Lat 30.24 no long

Sunday Oct ^{the} 1 day 1843
this 24 hours strong wind and equally weather
from the N.E. at sunset in all sail later part
heavy wind and rain and wind from all quarters

Mon ^{no} 2 this 24 hours
heavy wind and rain from all quarters later
saw S no lat Long 179.52 East

Tue ^{no} 3 this 24 hours
pleasant steering E.S.E. later light wind
and smoky weather saw a ship later wind E.S.E.
this day cross meridian Lat 31.01 Long 179.51 West

Wed ^{no} 4 this 24 hours light
wind from the N.W. steering E by S at sunset shortened sail
Lat 30.55 Long 179.30 West

Thu ^{no} 5 this 24 hours
fine weather I saw a ship to the S.E.
of our mid. 17.00 steering to the S.E. & later
to the E.S.E.

Fri ^{no} 6 day 1843
this 24 hours light squalls of rain at sunset in
sail ship heading E.S.E. later pleasant breeze

Sat ^{no} 7 this 24 hours strong breeze
from N.W. steering E.S.E. under double reefs
later wind N.E. and strong wind ship E.S.E. in sail

Sun ^{no} 8 this 24 hours heavy wind from
the N.E. no more ship 2 this 24 hours and strong wind

Mon ^{no} 9 this 24 hours
strong wind from the N.E. first part
spoke the ship Peruvian & St. Johns
later part saw 2 ships head winds and strong

Tue ^{no} 10 this 24 hours strong wind
from the N.E. ship under double reefs saw a ship
to the E. of our head wind Lat 30.15 Long 176.00

Wed ^{no} 11 this 24 hours
strong wind from the N.E. took several lines this
24 hours later fine air pleasant Lat 29.44 Long 175.35

Thu ^{no} 12 this 24 hours fine wind
and weather from the N.E. all sail out with a
head wind later light Lat 30.21 no long

Fri ^{no} 13 this 24 hours begins with light
air middle calm later saw a ship to the N.W. and
with calm Lat 30.29 Long 174.24 West

Sat ^{no} 14 first part light
breeze from the N.E. to N.W. steering to the East
later light air and hazy Lat 30.11 North

Sun ^{no} 15 this 24 hours begins with
light air from the North steering to the East and
later spoke ship Peruvian & St. Johns 24 miles
800 whale 300 sperm Lat 30.14 North
