Miss Jesse Hammond died very sudden on Saturday eve Jan 10th 1840. She had been as well as common during the day. After tea she sat down by the fire and said she was faint. They asked her if she would be put on the bed and she said she did not know as she was able to go there and she fell on the floor and was stiff. They put her on the bed and sent for the doctor. The doctor thought it was a stoppage so he gave her a slight emetic and she vomited twice & went up for supper and then he said she had not got a stoppage. In about 3 hours after she was taken she died. They called it an Apoplectic fit. She was subject to fainting.

July 21st Mother finished my mail to day. It has been quite a while since I wrote home. I have been very busy.
