 at 8 A.M. with a fresh breeze & cloudy weather took in flying jib for top gallant

 baromet 29.22 middle & latter part of the day fine breeze from S.W. to S.W. &
 dipping clouds steering by the wine heading from W.B. to S.W. to
 at 3 A.M. set fly jib & gaff top sail with empty in hauling off
 empty barrels & the hauled out barrel the day ends with a fine breeze heading

 we are coming up with her fast at sun down could see her half way
 up the main shrouds middle & latter part of the day fine breeze & fine weather
 at 8 A.M. weather steering S.W. nothing in sight so much this day
 baromet 29.22 Let in by log 3.36 South long in by chronomet 25.45 west & by baromet 25.12 west

 at 6 P.M. under all sail steering S.W. at 2 P.M. steamed S.W. middle & latter
 baromet 29.22 part of the day fine breeze & fine weather wine from S.E. to S.W. turned up
 the starboard boat & painted her the day ends fine weather nothing in sight
 at 8 A.M. Let in by log 5.35 South long in by chronomet 27.10 west & by baromet 26.08 west
 baromet 29.22

here 24 hours begins with a fine breeze from S.W. & fine weather steering
 at 6 P.M. empty in ship duty various kinds of work finished painting the starboard boat

 at 8 A.M. the day ends the same Let in by log 7.50 at long in by chronomet 28.06 west

 at 8 A.M. watch empty about the ship the day ends with light winds from
 baromet 29.22 S.W. & pleasant weather
