

203 Remarks on Sunday February 15th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with strong winds from NW & clear weather &
at 6 P.M. A ruggid sea on & growing ruggid & heading to the NW at 1 P.M.
brought 29²² took in all sail but A last reef Main top sail two shrouds & fore top
mast stop sail moderate gale at 6 P.M. A began to moderate
latter part of the day fine breeze from NW at 8 A.M. set double reef
at 8 A.M. top sail steering NW at 8 A.M. set all sail but the main sail at 11
brought 29²⁸ A.M. saw A strong sail to the windward the day ends with A moderate
breeze & A large swell on set in 74 35.07 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west

204 Remarks on Monday February 16th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with moderate breeze from NW to south & at
at 6 P.M. swell on bearing from the NW steering to the westward by the wind
brought 29²⁸ one strong sail in sight to the windward saw A plenty of birds at 3 P.M.
the wind began to huff to the south at 4 P.M. was clear & at sundown
shortened sail & steered to the Eastward by the wind & haling round to the East
at 4 P.M. the wind got round to ESE latter part of the day fresh breeze from
NE & E & cloudy & ruggid at 6 A.M. set hole top sails 1st & 2nd & 3rd
at 8 A.M. steering by the wind heading about NW watch employed in ships duty at 11 o'clock
brought 29²⁹ double reefed the top sails at midday took a ship to the SE & ruggid sea on
set in 74 31.15 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west

205 Remarks on Tuesday February 17th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with fresh breeze from NE & southerly & equally
at 6 P.M. weather & ruggid sea on heading to the SE under double reef top sails watch
brought 29²⁹ employed in ships duty picking oakum at 3 P.M. took in 1st & 2nd & 3rd
at sundown took in sail down to the shrouds last reef main top sail &
stop sail & took up the boats mizels & latter part of the day strong winds
from north to south thick weather raining by spells & A ruggid sea on
at 8 A.M. the wind halled round west at 9 o'clock the fore sail at 10 set
at 8 A.M. double reef fore top sail & double reef main top sail & steered NW & fair weather
brought 29³⁰ however had but A ruggid sea on at 11 past 11 steered NW & strong winds
ruggid set in 74 34.11 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west

206 Remarks on Wednesday February 18th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with strong breeze from NW & A heavy swell on &
at 6 P.M. fair weather strong wind under double reef top sails watch employed in picking
brought 29³⁰ picking oakum at 4 P.M. saw A strong big steering & at 4 past 11 was steered
NE & E blowing strong in squalls from NW to SE at 3 P.M. set the watch
& stored whole watches bound to the North at 2 past 8 turn one reef out of the
main top sail & set main top gallant sail more moderate wind & latter part of
the day fresh breeze & A heavy swell on at 5 A.M. set whole top sails at 7 set fore &
brought 29³² main top mast & top gallant shrouds in sails at midday went up main top
top gallant yard & set the top gallant sail so now this day more moderate
set in 74 32.52 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west

207 Remarks on Thursday February 19th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with fresh breeze from NW & fair weather & A heavy
at 6 P.M. swell on steering NE & E under all sail that will draw watch employed in ships
brought 29³⁰ duty the wind moderating down at 4 P.M. it halled ESE latter part of the day
fine breeze from NE to SE & fair weather & A heavy swell bearing from the North
steering by the wind to the NW watch employed in ships duty at 11 saw A hummingbird
data big steering to the SE for the day ends with A fresh breeze from NE
at 8 A.M. set in 74 31.40 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west
brought 29³⁰

208 Remarks on Friday February 20th 1852

There 24 Hours begins with A fresh breeze from NE & fair weather & bearing
at 6 P.M. on & A heavy swell bearing from the North watch employed in ships duty steering by
brought 29³⁰ the wind to the NW at 1 P.M. took in fore top gallant sail at 2 past 2 saw A
strong sail at 3 A hummingbird white big passed to the leeward of us steering to the
SE by the wind at 4 P.M. was taken ship & hauled SE & E & strong breeze at
3 P.M. took in main top gallant sail & top sail double reefed top sails furled
at 8 A.M. the main sail at 10 took in 1st & 2nd & 3rd & 4th & 5th & 6th & 7th & 8th & 9th & 10th & 11th & 12th
brought 29³⁰ thick weather ruggid sea on & strong winds at 8 A.M. began to make sail saw
the hummingbird white big A steered at 11 A.M. set main top gallant sail the day more
more moderate but thick smoky damp weather big in sight off our lee quarter
set in 74 31.31 South long in 7 chronomet 11 P.M. west
