

305 Remarks on Thursday May 27th 1852

There 24 hours begins with light winds from E & S & fine smooth weather
 at 6 P.M. steering by the wind to the south over towards Graciosa all hands employed in
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ putting blubber & boiling down one whaling brig one whaling longue
 & several merchant vessels in sight & fishlocks at 8 P.M. station sail
 got up. & at the watch much part of the day we had some small
 showers of rain latter part fine breeze & fine weather boiling saw the
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ barque Winthrop was at 9 A.M. & spoke & stood out to the S.W. by
 Graciosa saw fishlocks the day more with light winds & pleasant weather

306 Remarks on Friday May 28th 1852

There 24 hours begins with light winds from E & S & fine pleasant
 at 6 P.M. weather all hands employed in boiling at 2 P.M. back ship to the S.E.
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ in towards Graciosa barque Winthrop off our weather beam steering
 the same at 8 P.M. was ship to the S.W. the middle & latter part of the day fine
 breeze & fine weather all hands employed in boiling & looking out the foreward
 at 8 A.M. side of the after hole & steering down back barque Winthrop in sight
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ at 8 A.M. were ship in towards Graciosa we stood off round the west
 side of the island saw a plenty of fishlocks the day more fine weather

307 Remarks on Saturday May 29th 1852

There 24 hours begins with fine breeze from S.W. & fine weather we
 at 6 P.M. stood round the west side of Graciosa & then steered by the wind to the
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ E & S all hands employed in steering down back in the after hole at 2 P.M.
 finished boiling at 6 finished steering off the after hole put down 23
 bits of head & left one cask of head on deck & a cask of boar barque
 Winthrop in sight to the S.W. the middle & latter part of the day merchant
 breeze from W & S & fine weather at 8 A.M. set whole & spoke fish & spoke
 at 8 A.M. & looked out the starboard side of the fore hole to down down our oil the barque
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ Winthrop & 3 more speaking barques in sight off the east side of Graciosa
 saw for the first time the day more with moderate breeze & pleasant weather

308 Remarks on Sunday May 30th 1852

There 24 hours begins with moderate breeze from S.W. & fine weather
 at 6 P.M. the east side of Graciosa all hands employed in steering down oil & about
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ barque in sight at 1 P.M. we took her ship & steered by the wind to the S.W.
 for Graciosa at 4 P.M. got all stowed off & commenced washing of decks
 we have filled all of the ground tier with oil at 7 P.M. station sail
 got through washing of decks the barque Winthrop spoke to the S.W. of us
 on the opposite tack at 8 P.M. we were ship to the S.W. the middle & latter part
 at 8 A.M. of the day light winds & fine weather at 8 A.M. made all sail & were ship to the
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ W & Winthrop & our Lu beam at 9 calm weather & smooth sea between Gra-
 ciosa & Graciosa pleasant weather

309 Remarks on Monday May 31st 1852

There 24 hours begins with calm weather & smooth sea between Graciosa
 at 6 P.M. & Graciosa barque Winthrop 3 miles from us saw fishlocks birds &
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ porpoise at sun down shot and sail & headed up towards Graciosa being
 at 8 P.M. at 9 calm middle part of the day calm at 9 A.M. light breeze strong
 up from the S.W. made sail & stood off for Graciosa watch employed in
 at 8 A.M. ginning of oil & loading & mining knives & fitting up putting gun
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ barque Winthrop steering the same about 8 miles from us saw a plenty
 of fishlocks the day more with light winds & pleasant weather

310 Remarks on Tuesday June 1st 1852

There 24 hours begins with light winds from the south & fine smooth &
 at 6 P.M. pleasant weather steering to the south for the island Graciosa watch employed
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ in fitting up putting gun barque Winthrop 8 miles from us steering the same
 saw a plenty of fishlocks at 8 P.M. we got over to the S.W. part of Graciosa
 at 7 P.M. Mr. Henry mate of the Winthrop came on board at sun down station sail
 & steered by the wind to the S.W. & from the land at 9 the mate went on board middle &
 latter part of the day light winds & fine weather at 8 A.M. were ship in towards the
 at 8 A.M. land at 8 made sail & stood to the S.W. round the south part of Graciosa
 baromet 29.3⁸/₁₀ Winthrop & 3 merchant vessels in sight saw a plenty of fishlocks & porpoise
 watch employed in washing the lower steering over-port the ground tier the day
 more nearly calm & pleasant weather
