at 6 P.M. steering N.W. watch Employed in ship duty firing the new
BR 29²⁴ fore stay sails & other various kinds of work on big in sight steering
to the N.W. at 3 P.M. I caught one porpoise at 4 P.M. & command
breaking the blubber room & got out one keg of butter at 4 o'clock
by the wind to the S.W. at sun down shot and sail made & latter
part of the day moderate breeze from N.E. & pleasant weather at
at 6 A.M. 1/2 past 5 A.M. made sail & steered N.W. one french big in sight
BR 29²⁴ steering the same at midnoon exchanged signals with him
then N.W. so on this day saw one fin back whale
left in 704 21.17 South long in 7 chronometer 37.52 west

latter part of the day fresh breeze from N.E. & pleasant weather at 6 A.M.
at 6 A.M. made sail & steered N.W. one strong sail in sight commencing
BR 29²⁴ up the bar rising for & about at midnoon steered N.W. so on this day

clouds at 5 A.M. steered N.W. watch Employed about the rising set up
at 6 A.M. fore topmast shrouds & strong sails in sight steering to the S.W. at
BR 29²⁴ midnoon steered N.W. so on this day fresh breeze & ruff sea on
left in 704 23.33 South long in 7 chronometer 39.15 west

at 6 A.M. weather at 5 A.M. made sail & steered N.W. watch Employed about the
BR 29²⁴ rising saw one empty wine cask at midnoon steered N.W. so on this day
left in 704 24.18 South long in 7 chronometer 40.27 west

1194 Remarks on Thursday December 2nd 1852

at 6 P.M. watch Employed about the rising at 2 P.M. paper an empty wine cask at 3 steered N.W.
BR 29²⁴ at sun down shot and sail & steered by the wind to the S.W. at 12 was ship to the N.W. latter
part of the day fine breeze & smoky weather at 5 A.M. made sail & steered N.W. from the N.W.
at 6 A.M. the saw one whaling big steering to the S.W. watch Employed in ship duty saw one day
BR 29²⁴ left in 704 25.18 South long in 7 chronometer 41.15 west
