at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze steering for Dominica
 RR 29²³ Maria galanta in sight over Humphreys at 2 PM
 bent our chains & got ready for anchoring at sun down got
 round off Prince Rupert's head & started out & lay off & on
 through the night at 7 PM east wing came on board in his
 boat at 8 PM he went back in to the bay latter part of the day
 light winds at 5 AM made sail & commenced beating up in the
 bay at 8 PM 9 AM came to anchor in Prince Rupert's bay
 RR 29²³ got further out & commenced beating out empty sail & beating
 them to go on shore the Mattapoisett by her with 60 lbs
 of oil the day more fine weather

583 Remarks on Tuesday March 1st 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine weather laying to anchor in
 RR 29²³ Prince Rupert's bay in company with the Mattapoisett
 all hands employed in ship duty toward 10 empty cask on
 shore & cleaned off the ship out side for painting macle &
 latter part of the day fine weather all hands employed in working
 at 6 AM out at 11 AM the barque HD Chase capt Chase of
 RR 29²³ Beverly came in to anchor 3 months out 110 lbs the day
 new fine weather

584 Remarks on Wednesday March 2nd 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine weather laying to anchor in
 RR 29²³ Prince Rupert's bay in company with the HD Chase &
 Mattapoisett all hands employed in working out at sun
 down list of work macle & latter part of the day fine weather
 at 6 AM all hands employed in working out & starting off at 8 PM
 RR 29²³ 11 AM the barque osoteu Osoteu of New Bedford came to
 anchor 9 months out 75 lbs of sperm oil the day more
 fine weather

585 Remarks on Thursday March 3rd 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine weather & some passing showers
 RR 29²³ of rain laying to anchor in Prince Rupert's bay in company with
 3 whaling bargues all hands employed in beating out & starting
 off at 6 PM finished starting off & washed off decks macle & latter
 part of the day showering 5 barrels all hands employed in filling
 at 6 AM macle took on board 10 cask & stored down some of it out up some
 RR 29²³ wood on shore & brought on board & all the some over the stuns
 the day more fine weather laying to anchor

586 Remarks on Friday March 4th 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine weather laying to anchor in
 RR 29²³ Prince Rupert's bay in company with 3 bargues all hands employed
 in ship duty got off wood & storing it below & some water &
 catching the stuns & other various kinds of work on board macle
 at 6 AM & latter part of the day fine weather some small rain all hands
 RR 29²³ employed in painting the starboard side of the ship & the garous
 forward the day more the same laying to anchor

587 Remarks on Saturday March 5th 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fair weather laying to anchor
 RR 29²³ in Prince Rupert's bay in company with 3 bargues all hands
 employed in painting at 5 PM finished painting the starboard
 side & the garous forward macle & latter part of the day fine weather
 at 6 AM starboard watch employed in painting the masts & mast & the starboard
 RR 29²³ watch on shore on liberty the day more the same fine weather

588 Remarks on Sunday March 6th 1853

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine weather laying to anchor in Prince
 RR 29²³ Rupert's bay in company with 3 bargues starboard watch employed
 in painting masts & the starboard watch on liberty at 5 finished paint
 ing 3 parts at sun down the liberty men came on board all but
 at 6 AM Emmanuel Martin brought macle & latter part of the day some passing
 RR 29²³ rain signals at 8 AM the starboard watch went on shore on liberty
 the day more laying to anchor with all our flags set
