at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with light winds from NW & smooth
BR 29th 1/20 pleasant weather steering to the SE watch Employed in
ships duty saw Bluntmore Grampuses at Sun down Motioned
sail made & latter part of the day light breeze from NW &
fine pleasant weather at 5 AM made sail & steered NE watch
at 6 AM Employed in washing & cleaning there close on strong breeze
BR 29th 1/20 in beam this day once with light winds & pleasant weather
Left in 704 33.32 N Long in 74 Chronometer 47.02 West

19 Remarks on Saturday July 22nd 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with light air & wind from NW fine
BR 29th 1/20 pleasant weather steering NE watch Employed in washing there
close on strong breeze of our beam we saw Grampuses at Sun
down Motioned sail nearly calm made & latter part of the day
light winds from the NW & smoother weather at 5 AM made
at 6 AM sail & steered NW to the same breeze in sight watch Employed in
BR 29th 1/20 ships duty at Meriden stem NE so once this day
Left in 704 32.36 N Long in 74 Chronometer 46.32 West

20 Remarks on Sunday July 23rd 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with light breeze from the Westward &
BR 29th 1/20 pleasant weather steering NE watch Employed in ships duty
various kinds of work on strong breeze in sight at 11 AM steered NE
at Sun down Motioned sail & steered by the wind to the SE & wind from
at 6 AM the NW & latter part of the day light winds from the NW & calm
BR 29th 1/20 at 5 AM made sail & steered by the wind to the SE & at 10 AM the day was
calm Left in 704 33.01 N Long in 74 Chronometer 45.05 West

21 Remarks on Monday July 24th 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with calm weather at 1 PM a light breeze
BR 29th 1/20 blowing up from the NW to steered East at Sun down Motioned sail
latter part of the day light winds from NW & fine weather at 6 AM
made sail & steered by the wind to the NW & broke out the Blubber room
at 6 AM after iron flops & pumped 11 cask of fresh water out of the ground tier
BR 29th 1/20 saw one school of Black fish 2 miles this day fine weather
Left in 704 33.23 N Long in 74 Chronometer 44.58 West

22 Remarks on Tuesday July 25th 1854

There 24 Hours begins with light winds from the NW & fine weather
at 6 PM steering by the wind to the NW & watch Employed in storing fresh water
BR 29th 1/20 out of the ground tier & filling it with salt water & making 2 muzzles
Jugs & 2 ship tubs in room of the same number left at home at Sun down
Motioned sail & steered by the wind latter part of the day fine breeze from NW
at 6 AM the NW & at 5 AM made sail at 6 to 9 equally by shells watch Employed
BR 29th 1/20 in ships duty at Meriden stem & DE so once this day
Left in 704 34.17 N Long in 74 Chronometer 44.15 West

23 Remarks on Wednesday July 26th 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with moderate breeze from about NW
BR 29th 1/20 fine weather steering to the Eastward by the wind watch Employed
in ships duty various kinds of work washing & drying out stores for
Buckets at Sun down Motioned sail made & latter part of the day light
winds from the NW & calm at 5 AM made sail saw one whale in
at 6 AM passed off our beam quarter at 7 AM ship & board to the NW by the wind
BR 29th 1/20 watch Employed in ships duty this day once nearly calm
Left in 704 34.27 N Long in 74 Chronometer 43.25 West

24 Remarks on Thursday July 27th 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with fine pleasant weather & nearly calm
BR 29th 1/20 steering by the wind to the NW & watch Employed in ships duty
various kinds of work at 2 PM lost 11 PM found 3 boats for Black fish
got none at Sun down Motioned sail made & latter part of the day light
winds & fine weather at 5 AM made sail & steered by the wind blowing from
at 6 AM the NW & watch Employed in ships duty various kinds of work
BR 29th 1/20 so once this day light winds from NE to SE
Left in 704 35.04 N Long in 74 Chronometer no long to day

25 Remarks on Friday July 28th 1854

at 6 PM There 24 Hours begins with light winds from NE & some squalls
BR 29th 1/20 steering round steering to the Eastward by the wind watch Employed
in ships duty was made the caloon were smaller & the May saw
at Sun down Motioned sail made & latter part of the day light breeze
at 6 AM from the NW & calm & some passing rain squalls watch Employed
BR 29th 1/20 in washing there close this day once calm
Left in 704 35.33 N Long in 74 Chronometer 42.18 West
