 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from S.E. & blowing
 B.R. 29th the clouds steering by the wind to the Eastward at 1 P.M. set all sail
 larval sails in sight at 3 P.M. stem off to the S.W. at sun down
 shorten sail & lower the boat & went to a large stick of
 timber stem by the wind to the westward made & latter part
 of the day light breeze from N.W. with but little fine weather
 at 5 A.M. made all sail & stem by the wind to the S.W.
 at 6 A.M. watch Employed in ships duty one strong sail in sight saw at
 B.R. 29th plenty of grampuses & some porpoise so ends this day fine weather
 Let in by log 114.23 N Long in by chronometer 25.37 west

113 Remarks on Tuesday August 15th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with light breeze from N.W. & fine
 B.R. 29th weather steering by the wind to the S.W. watch Employed in ships
 duty fitting up the onion net & other various kinds of work &
 painted over my room saw a plenty of grampuses at 5
 lower the boat & went to a stick of timber & caught 3 fish at sun
 down shorten sail & wore ship to the Westward made & latter
 at 6 A.M. part of the day fresh breeze & rough sea saw several strong sails
 B.R. 29th at 10 came on squally & raining the day ends bad weather
 Let in by log 114.23 N Long in by chronometer 26.12 west

114 Remarks on Wednesday August 16th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with fresh from N.W. & rising gradually
 B.R. 29th & squally by spells backing to the N.W. by the wind under
 short sail at 3 P.M. the wind backed to the N.W. watch was ship
 to the S.W. from made & latter part of the day moderate breeze from
 the N.W. & fine weather at 5 A.M. made all sail & stem N.W.
 at 6 A.M. watch Employed in ships duty one sail in sight saw at plenty of
 B.R. 29th grampuses & porpoise the day ends fine weather
 Let in by log 113.53 N Long in by chronometer 27.12 west

115 Remarks on Thursday August 17th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from the N.W. & fine
 B.R. 29th weather steering by the wind to the S.W. backing N.W. watch
 Employed in ships duty carpenter making a potatoe pen
 saw a plenty of grampuses & porpoise at sun down shorten

Sail at 8 calm at 1 A.M. a light breeze sprang up from N.W. breeze
 at 6 A.M. ship to the N.W. at 5 made all sail watch Employed about the ship
 B.R. 29th carpenter making a potatoe pen plenty of grampuses in sight
 I fired a ball in the A. Bluntson grampuses saw one sail
 the day ends with a fine breeze & fine weather
 Let in by log 113.30 N Long in by chronometer 28.00 west

116 Remarks on Friday August 18th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from N.W. & good
 B.R. 29th weather steering by the wind the N.W. watch Employed about
 the ship at 2 P.M. the wind backed N.W. took a ship
 & stem N.W. at sun down shorten sail much part calm
 latter part moderate breeze from N.W. & fine weather at 5
 at 6 A.M. A.M. made all sail steering by the wind to the S.W. watch Employed
 B.R. 29th in working three line saw a plenty of grampuses at midday took a ship
 Let in by log 113.20 N Long in by chronometer 29.05 west

117 Remarks on Saturday August 19th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from N.W. & fine weather
 B.R. 29th steering N.W. by the wind under all sail watch Employed in working
 three line at sun down shorten sail much part calm latter
 fine breeze from N.W. at 4 made sail & stem by the wind to the
 N.W. at 9 A.M. the wind backed N.W. took a ship to the N.W. fine weather
 at 6 A.M. watch Employed in ships duty making a potatoe pen saw a plenty
 B.R. 29th of grampuses & several strong sails the day ends fine weather
 Let in by log 112.30 N Long in by chronometer 29.17 west

118 Remarks on Sunday August 20th 1854
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with a moderate breeze from N.W. & fine
 B.R. 29th fine weather steering by the wind N.W. watch Employed about the
 ship carpenter making a potatoe pen saw grampuses & sails
 at 3 P.M. stem N.W. at 4 went to a log at sun down shorten
 at 5 A.M. sail latter part of the day fine breeze from N.W. with but
 B.R. 29th 5 A.M. made all sail & stem by the wind to the S.W. saw
 a plenty of grampuses & strong sails the day ends fine weather
 Let in by log 111.06 N Long in by chronometer 29.17 west
