at 6 A.M. Employed about the ship got out flour & salted & other work on board

at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours begins with light winds from SE & fine weather
BA 29²/₁₀ fair weather steering 18 M watch Employed about the ship at 6 A.M.
found for Black fish got part to the Harbour but killed the fish & found
at 6 A.M. the rain & lost him came on board & steered 18 M with A fine breeze from
BA 29²/₁₀ E & NE inside & latter part of the day light winds & fine weather
at 6 A.M. found 2 boats for Black fish & got one small one to the Harbour but
so ends this day fine weather
