 6 A.M. made all sail & steered by the wind to the Eastward at 8 o'clock
 the two quarter boats for a right whale & he proved to be a
 at 6 A.M. hump back & calf we came in to green water saw a plenty of
 B.R. 29²² finbacks saw some fish at 9 boats came on board this day ends
 fine weather Lett in by 35.33 South long in by chronomet. 117.48

 at 6 P.M. These 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from west & fine weather
 B.R. 29²² under all sail steering by the wind to the Eastward watch Employed in
 ships duty was put fire brick in the stove & commenced burning
 coal at 1 P.M. even came out of green water in a blue &
 then we came in to an other green spot of water at 7 P.M. let the watch &
 stood whole watches bound over to the foreward & came much & latter
 part of the day fine breeze & fresh breeze by spillo from the north & down
 at 6 A.M. weather clearing & B.R. at 9 A.M. we saw a large gam of finbacks
 B.R. 29²² however took them to be sperm whales better at back for them this day ends fine weather
 Lett in by 35.56 South long in by chronomet. 45.10 west

118 Remarks on Monday November 27th 1854
 at 6 P.M. These 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from the north & down
 B.R. 29²² weather clearing & B.R. saw a barque steering N.W. mile & latter
 part of the day moderate breeze from the N.W. & fine weather watch
 Employed in ships duty at 10 A.M. saw a big steering to the N.W.
 at 6 A.M. this day ends fine pleasant weather & a smooth sea
 B.R. 29²² Lett in by 35.35 South long in by chronomet. 42.20 west
 on the night of November 26th 1854 I dream'd a dream that I was in weather
 now in a boat & went up to a house & Edwin with me I saw a good many in the house

 B.R. 29²² weather steering E.B. watch Employed in ships duty smooth sea on
 at 3 P.M. saw a whale spent some time bearing it & from us steered first
 saw nothing more of it at 4 past steered East much & latter part of the
 day moderate breeze fine weather watch Employed in ships duty saw
 at 6 A.M. one fin back & one school of porpoise this day ends good weather
 B.R. 29²² Lett in by 35.33 South long in by chronomet. 40.10 west

120 Remarks on Wednesday November 29th 1854
 at 6 P.M. These 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from the N.W. & down
 B.R. 29²² steering East watch Employed in ships duty at 3 P.M. saw a ship to
 the leeward steering by the wind to the N.W. & at 5 light breeze & variable
 & calm by spillo at 7 the wind bore up from the N.W. & latter
 part of the day light winds from west & to east & fine weather & at
 at 6 A.M. smooth sea steering by the wind to the Eastward watch Employed about
 B.R. 29²² the ship saw one fin back & porpoise this day ends fine weather wind
 Lett in by 35.110 South long in by chronomet. 30.30 west

121 Remarks on Thursday November 30th 1854
 at 6 P.M. These 24 Hours begins with light winds from E.N.E. & fine weather
 B.R. 29²² & a smooth sea steering by the wind to the E. saw porpoise mile
 & latter part of the day fine breeze from E. & to west & fine
 weather steering by the wind bearing from E. to E. watch Employed
 at 6 A.M. about the ship in ships duty this day ends fine weather wind
 B.R. 29²² Lett in by 35.32 South long in by chronomet. 36.112 west

122 Remarks on Friday December 1st 1854
 at 6 P.M. These 24 Hours begins with a fine breeze from E.N.E. & fine weather
 B.R. 29²² steering by the wind to the N.E. watch Employed in ships duty
 mile & latter part of the day moderate breeze from E.N.E. to E. & E.
 & fine weather steering by the wind to the N.E. watch Employed in washing
 at 6 A.M. there else this day ends fine weather nothing in sight but by day

 at 6 A.M. fine weather steering by the wind to the N.E. watch Employed in ships duty
 B.R. 29²² saw plenty of whale birds & geese this day ends fine weather
 Lett in by 37.50 South long in by chronomet. 34.50 west

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
