 P.M. Maria spoke at 4 past 5 saw a sperm whale track dist
 to 4 miles from us then for him & toward the leeward & wait
 boats & the whale went down heading & at 8 he soon came up &
 gun & hatch. & the leeward boat went up & got fast with
 both jibs & the whale run to the windward toward the starboard
 boat & the whale then down under water it came on Deck &
 the whale lounded & we cut off the line & came on board & then
 by the wind to the E. 18 at 3 past 2 were ship to the W. latter part of
 the day more moderate & not so ruff at 9 A.M. then at 2
