 at 6 A.M. saw porpoise this Day Ends with fine weather
 BR 29²² Lat in By 31.59 N Long in By Chronometer 49.42 west

344. Remarks on Monday June 11th 1855
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours Begins with a fine Breeze from N.E. & fine
 BR 29²² weather under all sail Steering by the wind to the N.E. saw porpoise
 at 3 P.M. I struck a porpoise & killed him with the iron brace of
 Mr. Spinnaker & lost him at Sun Down Shorten Sail at 12 noon ship to the N.E.
 at 6 A.M. Latter part of the Day fine breeze & fine weather at 5 A.M. was
 ship to the N.E. & made sail watch Employed in washing there else at 10
 at 6 A.M. this Day Ends fine weather nothing in sight
 BR 29²² Lat in By 33.07 N Long in By Chronometer 49.43 west

 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours Begins with a fine Breeze & fine weather Steering
 BR 29²² at 3 P.M. saw watch Employed in Ship's Duty at 3 P.M. saw a porpoise
 at Sun Down Shorten Sail Steering by the wind to the N.E. from
 3 P.M. at Sun Down A. Hermon's private Brig passed to
 theeward of us Steering to the N.E. at 12 noon ship to the
 N.E. at 5 A.M. was ship to the N.E. & made sail fine Breeze
 & good weather at 9 A.M. Rain & large whale off our lee
 beam going N.W. to the North at 10 hours 3 Boats for him
 & porpoise came up round him & jumped over him &
 galleyed him this Day Ends with a fine Breeze 3 boats off
 at 6 A.M. after a whale the whale started off to the windward

346. Remarks on Wednesday June 13th 1855
 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours Begins with a fine Breeze from about
 BR 29²² East & fine weather 3 boats off after a whale at 4 past
 1 P.M. came on board & commenced beating the ship to the
 windward the whale going to the windward galleyed
 at 4 P.M. we saw the whale 11 points off our weather bow 4 miles
 off at Sun Down Shorten Sail left out 5th & 6th Spinnaker Steering
 by the wind to the N.E. Latter part of the Day fine Breeze
 & good weather at 2 A.M. Tackled ship to the N.E. & at 5 made
 sail then by the wind Steering from N.E. to N.W. & at 8 P.M. watch
 at 6 A.M. Employed in Ship's Duty at Merion Tackled ship to the N.E.
 BR 29²² Lat in By 34.54 N Long in By Chronometer 49.38 west

 at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours Begins with a fine Breeze from N.E. & good
 BR 29²² weather Steering by the wind to the South watch Employed in
 Ship's Duty various kinds of work at 5 turned one boat over
 Blackfish got now at Sun Down Shorten Sail Middle &
 Latter part of the Day fresh Breeze & cloudy & ruff sea at
 5 A.M. was ship to the N.E. & made sail 5th & 6th Spinnaker watch Employed
 at 6 A.M. in Ship's Duty at Merion Tackled ship to the N.W. to end this Day
 BR 29²² Lat in By 34.16 N Long in By Chronometer 49.00 west
