at 8 A.M. this Day Endeavour with good weather some smoky
BR 29²⁷/₁₀ Let in by 36.20 or long in by Chronometer 33.12 west

1125 Remarks on Friday August 31st 1855
at 6 P.M. There 24 Hours Begins with light winds from the SE & good
BR 29²⁷/₁₀ weather & some smoky Steaming NE & watch Empty, in ship
Duty several sails in light one whaling barque off our starboard
bow Steaming as usual at 8 P.M. we spoke with the barque
Matta capt. King of New Bedford 14 months out 1150 bls & went
on board at 9 came from & New Bedford & Nicole & latter part of
the Day light breeze from the SE & fine weather & a heavy swell
coming from NE Steaming NE & watch Empty, in washing
there clear shelter at stern & 3 merchant vessels in light
