at 6 PM Three 24 fathom Buoys with light wires from 112 to 12 & five
B R 29²⁴₄₀ weather beating to the windward to get up to the buoy several
birds in light two whaling Barges & one schooner off at 3 o'clock
from at 1 P.M. were visible 13 1/2 to the 14th mile & latter part of
the day light Buoys from 12 to south & calm at 3 P.M. I went
at 6 PM on shore to the buoy after water & returned to the Barge
B R 29²⁴₄₀ when leaving off on the morning to cross the day

at 5 P.M. There 25 Thun in Bz, fine with a fine breeze from SE & good weather.
13 229^{3/4} Starting by the wind to the E & E watch Employe in starting up
on the 11th minute & when off our bearings at 4 P.M. there
to the 11th minute & latter part of the day breeze from SE
& good weather with Employe in starting our our boat at 7 A.M.
at 6 A.M. There 25 Thun in Bz, fine with a fine breeze from SE & good weather.
