 at 6 A.M. then 1 M. & watch Employed in Ships Duty
 saw two sails one of them at which we took Down

1117 Remarks on Friday Sept 21th 1855
 at 6 P.M. There 21 Hours Begins with moderate breezes from the
 B.R. 29th & fine weather Steering 1 M. watch Employed in
 Ships Duty at 3 then 1 E. at Dusk we saw Whales & Spouting
 we took them to B. sperm whales St. being to Dusk to
 ascertain got the line in the boats but saw nothing more of
 them shortened sail & then 3 watches latter part of the Day
 fine breezes from E.S.E. & fine weather at 6 A.M. were thick
 to the North & made suit watch Employed in washing
 then there I think a porpoise & lost him at 10 A.M. thick
 at 6 A.M. ship to the N.E. this Day Ende fine weather
 B.R. 29th latter in By 04 34.32 in long in By Chron 25.38 west

1118 Remarks on Saturday Sept 22th 1855
 at 6 P.M. There 21 Hours Begins with a fine breeze from E.S.E.
 B.R. 29th fine weather Steering By the wind to the N.E. watch
 Employed in washing & then there saw one Merchant
 Barge Steering to the North by the wind at 3 saw a then
 Morphriadite whaling Brig off our bow at sun
 Down shortened sail latter part of the Day light winds
 from E.S.E. to E.P.E. & fine weather Steering by the wind
 to the N.E. watch Employed about the ship the whole Brig
 off our bow Barge Steering the same we saw grampsons
 at 6 A.M. & saw Breeches this Day Ende fine weather
 B.R. 29th latter in By 04 33.53 in long in By Chron 24.10 west
