 Raised a ship & one Brig & heard of us standing
 towards us by the wind saw the ship run off to the
 Lward & then saw the Brig take a whale at long side
 we then off for the ship we saw several whales the
 Head 4 Boats off saw them get fast at 1/2 past 4 P.M. we
 heard 3 boats & her. & the whales to the Lward 10
 Minutes before Sun Down the Lward boat struck
 1st the whale & spouting his blood with the head from the
 waist boat got fast & the whale Lward & back the Lward
 boats line & part of the waist Boats went to the
 1st, 2nd & Lward to the windward came on Deck

 of the Day fresh Breers & Buss sea at 3 A.M. wore ship to
 the N.W. at 6 1st Double Reef & topsails course full &
 Spanker back out the fore Stole & got our 3rd main sail
 & Bent 1st & 2nd course the old one at Lward were
 at 6 A.M. ship to the N.E. to Enow this Day Buss & fresh Breers
 BR 29th Lat In By of 22.15 South Long In By Chron 9.52 East

our old main sail has been in use 47 months & 10
 Days.
