

620 Remarks on Wednesday March 12th 1856
at 6 P.M. There 21. Steam begins with fresh breezes & Ruff
BR 29¹⁴/₁₀ weather clearing by the wind to the S & W Gaming
with the thickening of new B. clouds at Sun Down
I came on Board & shooting sail & then to the S & E
& the thickening to the S & W Middle & latter part of the day
strong winds & Buzg. sea on at 3. A. A war ship to the S & W
at 7. Then under way two lights watch empty, about
at 6. A. A the ship at Anderson then S & E to end the day Buzg
BR 29¹⁴/₁₀ but in by 21.42 South by 7.110 East

These 24 hours begin with strong breezes & rough sea
 during E & W watch. Employed in ship's duty at sea
 Down Portland Spit & wore ship to the N.W. & lay under & under
 Reef main top sail. Latter part of the Day moderate wind
 at 6 A.M. then E & E & made sail at 10 A.M. we got
 at 6 P.M. all sail set this Day Ende light wind & good weather
 B.R. 29th Sunday March 16th 1858
 Lat. 50° 17.09 South Long. 130° 05 East
