 evening there clear at Sun Down Shortland sail & then
 by the wire to the N.E. & N.W. & latter part of the Day
 moderate breeze & fine weather at 6 A.M. at all sail
 at 7 A.M. raised whale off under board & a whole
 school of porpoise breaching over the whales & driving
 them down & to the windward just as I saw one & but
 for them I could not get up to the whales going
 quick to the windward gun up the chase & came on
 board at 1/2 past 10 & then by the wire heading S.E. & E
 at 6 A.M. saw two fairbanks so Endeavour this Day fine weather

 whole out of light to the windward we brook out the fore
 & got out at back of Anishon at 3 P.M. back to ship to
 the N.W. at Sun Down took in fly jib & left repairs
 latter part of the Day moderate breeze & fine weather at
 1 A.M. back to ship to the S.E. saw a plenty of porpoise
 at 6 A.M. some sign of this Day Endeavour with fine weather
 B.R. 29th Lat. In By of S. 27 South Long. In By Chron 9.35 East

737 Remarks on Tuesday July 8th 1856
 at 6 P.M. There 24 hours Breeze with light winds & cloudy
 B.R. 29th overcast morning. By the wire to the N.E. watch empty
 In evening off the main & backstays at Sun Down Shortland
 sail at 5 P.M. lay with the fore & topmast black things
 the night latter part of the Day light winds & cloudy
 weather at 6 A.M. at all sail & then by the wire to the
 S.E. at 1/2 past 9 saw a small school of very small
 sperm whales 1 point off our bow all together &
 going quick to the N.W. we lowered our boats for them
 but we could not come up with them & they went
 out of light to the windward we all got on board
 at 6 A.M. the past moon & the wire very light so Endeavour this Day
 B.R. 29th Lat. In By of S. 34 South Long. In By Chron 9.34 East
