 out all the line but one fluke it came on Dark & the
 whale Run to the head & some more whales with the head
 on 2 Drags & left the line to them at 9 P.M. were got the
 small whale fluked at long side & left the watch fresh bears
 & cloudy & Dark Steady sail & day by the whale at night



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
