I dreamed that I was in a boat in western river near the Hornsuck point with Edwin & several more men & we pulled the boat up to the shore below my house & Edwin & I went up to a house it seemed to me to be up to Metham Standalone & in the house I saw several men & women & among them was Nancy Magowan & Diannah Gory I asked Diannah if my family was well & the first name of them was I asked that a son & she said that Eliza was gone to her home & I began to shed tears & I saw Edwin talking with Nancy & he & I went out of doors & he told me that my wife Dicie in child birth & then I looked & saw a house that they said was mine & I saw Julia rocking a child in her arms but the house did not look like mine to me but I saw Julia in it with a child in her arms rocking it in a chair with no rockers on it
