 at 4 pm took in foretopsail at 8 pm light wind Ship heading
 North West heavy rain at daylight wore Ship heading S. E.
 one sail in sight the San Francisco
 Lat 36.40 Long 36.34

Wednesday Comm' with strong wind Ship heading S. E. at 2 pm spoke bark
 June third San Francisco at 4 pm wore Ship. Wind strong breeze at daylight
 18.57 More Moderate saw a large log of wood lowered and
 took it along side found it sound took off 14 feet and let
 the rest go. Breeze forward with thick squally weather latter
 More Moderate made some sail wind north S. E. end
 Lat 37.09 Long 35.06

Thursday Comm' with strong wind from the S. E. the other
 three sail. Breeze in company at 7 pm double reefed topsails
 18.57 Puffed to the North West Part heavy winds at daylight
 More Moderate made all sail Stearing E. the other
 Bark in sight this End
 Lat 38.29 Long 34.00

Friday Comm' with fine breeze from the N. Course & with
 a heavy swell at 1 pm saw a shoal of sperm
 whales coming to windward quick down tacks
 hauled on the wind at 2 pm lowered two boats chased
 without success whales going up and at 4 pm came on
 board the other bark lowered got nothing at 7 pm
 shortened sail heading to the westward at midnight
 wore Ship heading E. at daylight made all sail
 4 sails in sight one water repairing boat sails at
 Meridian took Ship heading S. E. nothing in sight
 this End

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Saturday Comm' with whole sail breeze from S. E. Course S. E.
 nothing in sight at 7 pm shortened sail for the night
 June 6th at daylight fine clear weather made all sail 2 sails
 in sight at 8 am spoke brig harriet of Harpsburg
 Captain came on board for a small cask of water
 they being short bound to Quebec latter Stearing S. E.
 this End nothing in sight
 Lat 38.30 Long 33.55

Sunday Comm' with fine breeze from S. E. Course S. E. at
 7 pm shortened sail for the night luffed to the wind
 June 7th at 9 pm kept off S. E. and fine at daylight made all
 sail Stearing S. E. latter the same nothing in sight
 Lat 37.33 Long 32.54

Monday Comm' with light breeze and smoky weather Course
 S. E. & S. nothing in sight at 7 pm took in light sails at
 June 8th daylight made all sail at 6 am saw the island of Flores and
 Curve Stearing S. E. at Meridian were dist 2 miles then S. E.
 Lat 39.38 Long 32.41

Tuesday Comm' with strong breeze Ship heading S. E. took in
 light sails. Emptyed it. Getting up Backstays at 7 pm
 June 9th kept off S. E. and the same at daylight made all sail
 the island of Pangel and Pico in sight at 11 am the island
 of St. George ahead at Meridian kept off for Graciers.
 Linbacks in sight this End
 Lat 39.16 Long 28.06

Wednesday Comm' with fine clear weather Stearing for Graciers at 7 pm
 dist 2 miles took in light sails hauled on the main off.
 June 10th Spoke chain yard black at daylight made all sail
 heading in there at 8 am Capt went on Shore for trade
 this End Calms
