 (Tuesday) Light and one sail at 7 pm ship heading S.E.
 28 Mid Moderate latter thick and m. ch
 backing out fore hold thus End

(P.M.) Comm' with fine whole sail breeze from S.W.
 (Wednesday) ship heading S.E. at 4 pm Sam and sail at 5 pm
 29 shortened sail for the night at 2 am rain
 at 6 am fine made all sail 2 sails in sight
 later got 4 sails in sight Marchmont ship
 this End

(P.M.) Comm' with whole sail breeze from the west ship heading
 (Thursday) north 3 sails in sight at 3 pm Barred Barren Elisa
 (July 30) of New York bound East at 4 pm struck a porpoise
 at 7 pm took in light sails mid strong winds with
 thick weather ship heading S.W. this End
 Lat

(P.M.) Comm' with strong winds and thick weather
 (Friday) at 2 pm tacked ship heading S.W. at 7 pm
 (July 31) singled reefed mid thick weather at 8 am made
 all sail heading S.W. one sail lock in sight & End
 Lat 44.52 Long 28.16

(P.M.) Comm' with light breeze from the westward ship
 (Saturday) heading S.W. at 7 pm shortened sail mid light
 (August) breeze with foggy latter one watch getting out
 (first) weather thus End clear weather
 Lat 47.52 Long 39.39

(P.M.) Comm' with light air Porpoise in sight at 6 pm tacked ship heading S.W.
 (Sunday) all sail set at 4 am wind increasing double reefed at 6 am
 (August 1st) Sam 3° sperm whales to midward coming to Leeward Landed
 3 boats Starboard boat struck blowing heavy line got afoul
 took the boat down and stowed for the other two boats fastened to the
 whale at 10 am got stowed boat along side with the loss of
 line and steering ear and several small articles at 11 am got
 whole along side blowing light gale from the north with rain
 thus End with all hands to dinner

(P.M.) Comm' with light gale and very rugged at 2 pm finished
 (August) breaking out fluker room and new ship, and hooked on it
 (third) 6 pm Knocked off head stays putting very rugged cutting
 at 8 pm put out another boat shortened sail set the watch
 at daylight new ship, and hooked on with a heavy swell running
 had cutting light rain at 9 am got off head and began on
 laddy thus End
